

Although we have not yet received formal written notification from Coastal Commission Staff, we believe that no timely appeal was filed. Staff will be working with Mrs. Ginsburg to fulfill any conditions of approval that need to be met prior to the opening of the museum to the public. Among these conditions is the adoption of a City Council policy for the designation of historic buildings and properties, which will appear on the upcoming February 3rd City Council agenda.

CITY HALL CLEAN UP DAY – FEBRUARY 16th



There are a few holidays throughout the year when most government offices are closed, but that are not paid holidays for our City staff. One such holiday is Presidents' Day, which falls on Monday, February 16th. This holiday tends to be very quiet, because most people expect City Hall to be closed. **FY12-13 & FY13-14 RESIDENTIAL STREETS REHABILITATION PROJECT,
AREAS 1, 5B, & 9: CONSTRUCTION BEGINS**

Construction began this week in Area 1, which is the residential area bordered by Silver Spur Road on the east, Hawthorne Boulevard on the south, and the City of Palos Verdes Estates on the west and north. The initial preparatory work is being performed, including the repair of damaged sections of concrete curb and gutter, which will be followed by localized asphalt concrete repair and crack-sealing of the roadway. Temporary No Parking signs are placed in the street at least 72 hours in advance of enforcement to alert the public of the specific areas where on-street parking will be restricted in order to enable the performance of the repair work. Following work in Area 1, the crews will be moving into Area 5B (in the southwestern part of the City), and then into Area 9 (in the eastern part of the City). STORMWATER QUALITY WEBSITE UPDATES

Two separate but related items of interest will be added to the City's Stormwater Quality webpage this week. The first is regarding the MS4 Permit, which regulates the City's drainage system, and requires a little background.

Although the Permit was adopted by the Regional Board in late 2012, several cities including RPV filed a petition asking the State Board (parent agency to the Regional Board) to review some of the permit conditions. Environmental organizations, representing a different point of view, also filed petitions. The State Board has responded to the disputed issues by way of an "Order" which was published in draft form in November last year. A public workshop was held in December and a 60-day written comment period has now expired. The City provided written comments via the City Attorney's office on behalf of 19 petitioning cities, including RPV. The State Board will take input from these sources and issue a "Final Order" in the coming weeks or months. The second item is similar in that relates to the City's MS4 Permit implementation plan, called and EWMP (for Enhanced Watershed Management Program). The City joins the County and many other permittees (cities) in this approach to the permit. The County felt it necessary to develop environmental documentation for this county wide approach to stormwater quality and has now published a Draft Program Environmental Impact Report for the EWMPs. According to the Notice of Availability, the document "serves as the first-tier environmental document that focusses attention on the effects of implementing the EWMP overall as plans to reduce urban runoff pollution." The documents are available on the City's Stormwater Quality Program webpage (<http://palosverdes.com/rpv/publicworks/stormwater-quality/index.cfm>) for review. The review period extends to March 9, 2015.

TREE GRID TRIMMING

Citywide Tree Grid Trimming is scheduled to begin in Area 9, on February 2, 2015. The work in Area 9 is expected to last approximately 30 working days.

UPDATE ON LOCAL COASTAL PLAN AMENDMENT FOR FLAG POLES IN THE COASTAL ZONE

On November 4, 2014, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2014-73, amending the Visual Corridor Section of the City's Local Coastal Plan (LCP) to allow flag poles up to 70-feet in height in the City's Coastal Zone that meet specific standards. Since any proposed amendments to an LCP must also be approved by the California Coastal Commission, on December 4, 2014, the Council-approved LCP Amendment was submitted to the California Coastal Commission for processing.

City Staff was informed this week that the City's LCP amendment will be placed on the February 12, 2015 Coastal Commission Agenda in Pismo Beach. City Staff intends to attend this Coastal Commission hearing. Additionally, Staff will update the City's website and notify list-serve subscribers of the upcoming February 12th Coastal Commission hearing.

MINOR MODIFICATION APPROVAL FOR INTERIOR RETAINING WALLS AT THE CRESTRIDGE SENIOR CONDO PROJECT

At the last city council meeting, the council asked staff about the recently constructed walls along Crestridge Road that are part of the crestridge senior condo development. Given that the Council expressed some concerns at their last meeting over the staff level minor modification that was approved for the retaining walls along Crestridge Road, we are informing the Council via this weekly report of another minor modification request.

The applicant is seeking approval of 15 new interior retaining walls, which will vary in height between 3 and 8.3 feet in height within the interior of the site in and around the various units (see attached list and site plan). The project approved by the City Council included

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the approval of 3 6-foot retaining walls at the western-most portion of the project site (which are also proposed to change in height) but did not include any retaining walls within the remaining portion of the site. According to the developer, these walls became necessary as a result of the Building & Safety Plan Check process for the following reasons:

1. As the project has moved from entitlement to construction, it became apparent that additional retaining walls were necessary to satisfy drainage requirements and ADA criteria;
2. ADA accessibility criteria affected a larger area of the site which required retaining walls to create more paths, ramps and flatter areas throughout the site; and,
3. Drainage refinements during final design has required changes to the grades and the need for additional walls or changes to the height of walls to better direct and control on-site drainage.

Pursuant to City Council Condition of Approval No. 6, "the Community Development Director is authorized to approve minor modifications to the approved plans or any of the conditions if such modifications achieve substantially the same results as would strict compliance with said plans and conditions." Staff intends to approve these necessary retaining walls as a minor modification since the walls will be located in the interior of the development in manner that will blend with the landscaping and would not be visible from Crestridge Drive and have limited visibility from neighboring properties.

If any Councilmember disagrees with this request being approved as a Staff level minor modification, please contact the Acting City Manager Director Rojas by the end of the day on Monday February 2nd, so we can agendize this matter for the February 17, 2015 City Council meeting.




PARKS MASTER PLAN UPDATE WORKSHOPS CONTINUE THIS WEEK

The Parks Master Plan Update public outreach effort continues, with public workshops scheduled every Wednesday through February 25th. Attendees will see a presentation on the site including current uses, past plans for the site and land use restrictions, to be followed by a discussion of possible future uses and a review of the public outreach response to date. The results of the previous November 19, 2014 Point Vicente Park/Civic Center workshop will be discussed as well.
