CALPERS ESTIMATES IMPACTS TO CHANGES IN ASSUMPTIONS

During the CalPERS Pension and Health Benefits Committee meeting on March 19th, Chief Actuary Alan Milligan proposed five policy amendments addressing the current smoothing and amortizing methods in which CalPERS calculates member contribution rates. Last week, staff provided a one page summary in the Weekly Report of the proposed changes and the potential impacts on the City if the CalPERS Board ultimately decides to approve the recommendations.

Along with the CalPERS staff report, several attachments were included that discuss some of the impacts the proposed policies would have on liability pools. The tables below summarize the impact that adopting the proposed changes for smoothing and amortizing would have on cities with a Miscellaneous Plan, like Rancho Palos Verdes' pension plan.

Sample Public Agency Miscellaneous Plan – Attachment 2

It appears that Mr. Milligan expects a 3.2% increase in the average employer contribution rate as a result of his proposals. As a reminder, the City's current employer contribution rate for first-tier employees is 13.914%.

As reported last week, a change in the mortality rate is expected to have an approximate 2% impact for miscellaneous plans that will be phased in over a five year period (increase of about 0.4% per year). Based on the information we have so far, it seems unlikely that our employer contribution rate will increase 50% by FY15-16, as has been reported in a recent news article.



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE ON PHASE I OF THE FY11-12 RESIDENTIAL STREETS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, AREAS 3 AND 5

Concrete repair work began this week on the residential streets surrounding Point Vicente Elementary School, including Berry Hill Dr., Rue Beaupre, Rue de la Pierre, Rue la Fleur, Rue Langlois, Via Collado, and Via Cambron. In addition, localized full-depth asphalt removal and replacement will be performed on some of these streets, including Via Rivera, on Thursday and Friday this week. The crew will be returning to Maintenance Area 3 next week to continue concrete repair work in that residential area, including locations on Blackhorse Rd, Diamondhead Ln, and Silver Arrow Dr.

Egg Hunt Eggstravaganza This Saturday






