

SAN RAMON CANYON PROJECT UPDATE

Tunneling continues for the slant drain this week as the contractor has just reached the 100 foot milestone in the approximately 300 foot tunneling effort from bluff top to the beach. Preparations are also being made to excavate the trench for the intermediate section of pipe known as the “cut and cover” section. This section is about 1800 feet long and involves excavating a trench from the surface, laying the pipe in the trench and backfilling over the pipe. This week the contractor is performing a “pre-cut”, which is the first part of his trenching activity. Bedding sand, which is placed in the trench bottom before the pipe is installed, is also arriving this week.

At the upper part of the canyon, the contractor has begun drilling 24-inch diameter vertical holes in the earth at the location of the inlet structure. These holes are being filled with a steel rebar cage and concrete to form piles, which will become the foundation of the inlet structure and retaining walls at the top end of the project. In addition, the contractor has been working to install inlet structures and a pipe across PVDE at the upper switchback. That work should be completed this week after the asphalt has been replaced in the roadway. A final slurry coat will be applied toward the end of the project to seal and protect all the asphalt repairs that will be required for the project.



RPV CALIFORNIA COASTAL TRAIL (CCT) PROJECT CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The City's contractor (Land Forms Construction) has begun work on another segment of the Coastal trail which is located at Palos Verdes Drive West between Marguerite Dr. and Calle Entradero. Work includes grading and placement of Decomposed Granite (DG) over the trail surface; installation of landscaping and an irrigation system on the parkway (the area between the trail edge and the road curb). Construction work at Lower Point Vicente near the Palos Verdes Interpretive Center (PVIC) is in progress also.

The City's segment of the CCT extends the entire length of the City's coastline between the boundary lines of the City of Palos Verdes Estates and the City of Los Angeles. The total length of the RPV segment of the CCT is approximately 9 miles. This project will improve 2.5 miles of this segment. The rest of the trail length has either been improved previously or is part of the naturally compacted surface trails which exist in the City's Preserve.

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
