ROLLING HILLS SEWER PROJECT

Staff is organizing a meeting with Los Angeles County to discuss and understand how an extension (into Rolling Hills) to a Rancho Palos Verdes sewer was put in place. Records indicating discussions and approval of an extension are not available in our files.

The County has indicated they will approve expansion of the line. The section being extended will connect to a sewer line which runs through easements in the back yards of properties in Rancho Palos Verdes located along Middlecrest Road then flow is routed through a line on Robinview Lane onto Crenshaw Blvd where it continues to Los Angeles County.

Rancho Palos Verdes is responsible for capacity and content related issues specific to the sewer lines which it owns. Accordingly, Staff is concerned and is working to determine how the line was extended into Rolling Hills and to develop an agreement with Rolling Hills to address capacity and environmental concerns.

SAN RAMON CANYON PROJECT UPDATE

This week the contractor began laying the pieces of 54-inch steel pipe for the project. Excavation of about 400 feet of trench length was completed prior to laying any pipe. The trench is then cut to the correct elevations and the bottom of the trench prepared with bedding material (sand). The 50-foot pipe lengths, known as "sticks" are laid in the trench



and pressed together using the bell and spigot joints. The joints will then be stabilized by tack welding. The pipe will be buried after all 400 feet of pipe have been installed, late this week and early next. Following backfilling, then next section of trench, which is the deepest section, will be excavated. Final welding of the interior joints will be completed at a future time in the construction schedule.

PUBLIC WORKS PERMIT REPORT

The Public Works Department is responsible for control of work performed within the City Public “Rights of Way”. An Encroachment Permit is required to insure that any applicant working in our streets or parkways is properly licensed, insured and in compliance with the NPDES requirements.


