1. HEIGHT VARIATION PERMIT, GRADING PERMIT AND SITE PLAN REVIEW (CASE NO. ZON2010-00144): 4 Avenida de Azalea / Chin (LM)

Request: A request to construct a 951 square foot first and second story addition to the existing 4,049 square foot residence (garage included). The overall height of the residence will measure 25'-2" as measured from the highest existing ridgeline (elev. 1381.95') to the lowest finished grade adjacent to the foundation/slab (elev. 1356.79'). The project also includes 92 cubic yards of associated grading and a 115 square foot deck.

ACTION: ADOPTED P.C. RESOLUTION No. 2011-08 AS MODIFIED, THEREBY CONDITIONALLY APPROVING THE HEIGHT VARIATION PERMIT (CASE No. ZON2010-00144), (5-0).

Request: A request to construct an 867ft² two-story addition to an existing two-story residence. The overall height of the residence will increase from 21'-9" to 23'-6", as measured from the point where the lowest foundation or slab meets finished grade to the ridgeline of the residence.



Whale of a Day is almost here! The 27th annual Whale of a Day Celebration will be held next **Saturday, March 5**, from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. at the Point Vicente Interpretive Center. The public will park at City Hall, where free shuttles, provided by County Supervisor Don Knabe's Office, will transport visitors to PVIC for the festivities. RPVTV will be on hand to film the event. Some of the highlights of the day will include:

- Free tours of the Point Vicente Lighthouse and Interpretive Center
- Fun booths, with food and entertainment throughout the day
- Face Painting
- Educational opportunities for children and adults
- Arts and crafts for children
- Performance by the San Pedro High School Marching Band

- Organizations represented will include El Dorado Nature Center, Marine Mammal Care Center, L.A. County Sheriffs Dept., Aquarium of the Pacific, L.A. County Fire Dept., Cabrillo Marine Aquarium, PVP Land Conservancy, Point Fermin Lighthouse Society, South Bay Wildlife Rehab, International Bird Rescue, PVP 4H Club, Save the Manatee, Los Angeles Regional Agency, EDCO, L.A. County Vector Control, California Native Plant Society, RPV Traffic & Safety Commission, and Wildlife Waystation.
- Stage Entertainment including Beach City Cloggers, Master's Choice Martial Arts Demonstration, Barbershop Quartet, live surf music from the band Midnight Ride, dance performance by Dance 4 Oceans, and Geoff Agism's Sea Shanties.
- Food will be provided by Pina's Mexican Restaurants, Krispy Sweet Corn and Los Serenos de Point Vicente Docents

Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) Rangers

- Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) Rangers have submitted their activity report for the period of December 2010 through January 2011. The City contracts with the MRCA to patrol the Palos Verdes Nature Preserve and to provide enforcement services within the Palos Verdes Nature Preserve and interpretive services to the community. For this reporting period, MRCA Rangers reported slightly fewer park visitors due to the rainy days in December; 500-650 Preserve visitors. Rangers warned and advised ten visitors, and issued seven citations. Most warnings and citations were associated with the public having their dogs off leashes. Rangers performed maintenance in the Preserve, including removal of graffiti and litter. MRCA Rangers are beginning to offer more interpretive services in the community, and in December and January spoke with members of the Peninsula Seniors at Hesse Park and PVIC, worked with Recreation and Parks staff on the popular new Junior Ranger Program, and made preparations for a new City recreational offering: Ranger-led moonlight night hikes. Please find attached MRCA activity report.

Night Hikes

- Unfortunately, the Saturday, February 19th Public Night Hike had to be cancelled due to rain. We are currently working with the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) Park Rangers, to schedule a replacement hike.

Docent-led PVIC Tours and Abalone Cove Hikes

- On Saturday docents will lead 50 students of Berendo Middle School on a hike to Abalone Cove, sharing information on the tide pools and pollution.
- On Saturday, docents will lead 50 students from Berendo Middle School on a tour of the Point Vicente Interpretive Center, sharing information on whales and local history.

Backpack Flier Program

In a continuing effort to maximize exposure to the Recreation and Parks Department's new recreation programs and target local families, the Department participated in the PVPUSD Backpack Flyer program, offered by PVPUSD in conjunction with the PVP Coordinating Council. The "backpack flier", highlighting the City's recreation programs, will be sent home with PVPUSD school children to 5,000 families in mid- March. See attached flier.

Abalone Cove Shoreline Park – Report of possible unauthorized activity at the lifeguard stand by professional kayakers early Saturday and Sunday mornings. Changed patrol hours in order to make contact. No contacts. Weather and early morning low tides decreased activity at tide pools during park hours.

Abalone Cove Reserve (Sacred Cove) – We continue to see a diverse group of people using the cove. We issued a nude sunbathing citation and three (3) No dogs on beach. The weather decreased activity. We have identified (3) three new locations for possible lewd activity. We found unauthorized trails and litter including but not limited to used condoms, wrappers and toilet tissue. The activity has moved to the north end of sacred cove, the top of the reserve and off trail at Portuguese Point.


Portuguese Bend - All user groups were present during this period. We had some rain days in December and the park usage dropped considerably due to trail conditions. The trails on the lower portion of reserve were damaged due to debris flow caused by the rains. (*see PBPT photos*) Trail markers are unclear at Toyon/Landslide/Peppertree/Garden trail junction. Recommend opening "Landslide Scarp" trail to mountain bikers.

Forrestal Reserve – Park usage continues to be in the early morning hours and after work hours. Soccer fields continue to be used as off leash Dog Park.
