

SAN RAMON CANYON SEWER RELOCATION PROJECT

The San Ramon Canyon sewer relocation project is progressing well and is likely to be complete ahead of schedule. The following changes have been made to the sewer relocation contract with Garcia Juarez, which have required use of contingency funds provided for the project as follows:

- To facilitate construction ahead notification to drivers, the requirement for two Changeable Message Signs was added to the contract. They are setup on each side of the work area, well in advance of the project to enhance the safety in the work area. These signs are to remain operational for the duration of the project.
- While constructing the project, it was found that 10 guardrail posts were completely rotted and the contractor was instructed to replace them.
- Differing site conditions required issuance of a change order to install engineered fill at the storm drain outlet located near the upper switch-back.

The cost of these changes are within the contingency limit established by City Council for the project. All changes to the contract will be outlined in the final staff report for this project when Notice of Completion is requested.




