PENINSULA REGIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT CRIME STATISTICS

Attached for the Council's information are pertinent excerpts from the statistics presented at the Peninsula Regional Law Enforcement Committee meeting held on August 10, 2011. Unless noted otherwise, the data presented is for the second quarter of 2011 (April through June).

Part 1 Crimes – Year to Date Comparison for 2010 and 2009

Law enforcement agencies across the county use the FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) system to collect and report crime statistics. Part 1 crimes consist of the eight most serious offenses including homicide, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny theft, motor vehicle theft and arson.

Part 2 Crimes – Year to Date Comparison for 2010, 2009 and 2008

Part 2 crimes include 22 categories of offenses ranging from simple assaults to vagrancy.

Traffic Statistics

Please note that the "Traffic Enforcement Index" is a ratio of the number of hazardous traffic citations issued to the number of injury collisions. An index higher than 20 is considered to be good.

Sheriff Response Time Performance

The Sheriff's goals for response times are under 7 minutes for Emergency Calls, under 20 minutes for Immediate Calls and under 1 hour for Routine Calls.

Ambulance Response Statistics

The ambulance company's goal for response times is 90% under 9 minutes.





FINANCIAL SYSTEM ACQUISITION PROJECT STATUS

This is the third report in a series of project status updates.

The Request for Proposal (RFP) for the replacement of the City's computer financial system was issued August 8th, and can be found at the following link on the City's website:

<http://www.palosverdes.com/rpv/finance/RFP-Finance.cfm>

The announcement of the RFP was sent to more than 100 software vendor contacts. Staff and the City's RFP consultant, Mike Mucha of the Government Finance Officers' Association (GFOA), will conduct a pre-proposal conference to address vendor questions on August 18th. Vendor proposals are due September 9th. By September 23rd, Staff expects to select up to 3 vendors to conduct in-house demonstrations; which will be conducted the weeks of October 31st and November 7th. The project is still on schedule to recommend a vendor contract to the City Council in February 2012.

To keep the City's options open, the RFP was written to include several scope options; from a basic financial system to a fully integrated Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system, including both permitting and work order management, as well as modules that may facilitate recreational activity registration and facility rental. As such, Staff expects to receive a wide range of cost proposals from vendors. The current budget for purchasing the system is about \$450,000. Staff will continue to keep the City Council informed of the project status.





UPDATE ON CRENSHAW BLVD AT CRESTRIDGE RD TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The new traffic signal is up and running and the contractor is working on some remaining punch list items as the project wraps up. One of the remaining items to be completed is the connection of the vehicle detection loops in the roadway. Thus, until this has been completed, motorists may experience a slight delay at this intersection while waiting for the traffic signal to cycle though all of the directions of traffic it serves. Once the loops have been reconnected, which is anticipated to be complete within the next week, this delay will no longer be present. Staff appreciates the continued patience of motorists travelling through this intersection while the construction work is completed.


