### **RECRUITMENT FOR THE FINANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE, PLANNING COMMISSION AND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE FOR THE WATER QUALITY FLOOD PROTECTION PROGRAM**

Staff is currently recruiting for: three seats on the Planning Commission; three seats on the Oversight Committee for Water Quality Flood Protection Program; and, one vacancy on the Finance Advisory Committee. Please see the attached Press Release which was issued on November 17, 2011 regarding the recruitment. The Press Release has been sent to the Palos Verdes Peninsula News (PV News) and Daily Breeze and posted on the website, ListServe, Access Reader Board on Channel 35, and RPV TV Ch 33. In addition, a Public Notice and an advertisement regarding the recruitment will be published in the PV News and Daily Breeze, and the Public Notice will be posted in various locations throughout the City. The deadline for applications to be filed in the City Clerk's Office is by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 6, 2012. Interviews with the City Council are anticipated to take place in mid to late January 2012. The City Clerk's Office will confirm the date and time of the interviews with the applicants.

Staff has invited current Committee/Commission Members, whose terms of office are expiring, to apply for reappointment if they are interested in continuing to serve on their respective Committee/Commission. As a reminder, current Committee/Commission Members' terms of office are automatically extended, if necessary, until the City Council completes the interview and appointment process.

**RECRUITMENT FOR THE CITY OF RANCHO PALOS VERDES PLANNING COMMISSION;  
OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE FOR WATER QUALITY FLOOD PROTECTION PROGRAM; AND,  
A VACANCY ON THE FINANCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

The City of Rancho Palos Verdes has begun the recruitment process for applicants for three of the City's Advisory Boards. Residents interested in their City government are encouraged to become involved and apply for appointment to these various boards. The following positions will be available for appointment in early 2012: three seats on the Planning Commission; three seats on the Oversight Committee for Water Quality Flood Protection Program (Oversight Committee); and, one seat (vacancy) on the Finance Advisory Committee created as a result of the recent election. The term of office for the Planning Commission and Oversight Committee is four years, while the unexpired term of office for the Finance Advisory Committee ends in December 2014. These are volunteer, non paying positions.

The seven member Planning Commission makes decisions on specific private land use planning applications such as subdivision maps, variances, and conditional use permits; reviews environmental assessments, such as Environmental Impact Reports and Negative Declarations;

makes decisions on view restoration permits; and considers appeals of staff decisions on land use planning applications. The Planning Commission holds evening meetings on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month.

The five member Oversight Committee for the Water Quality and Flood Protection (storm drain) Program serves to ensure that the Storm Drain User Fee enacted by the vote of the affected property owners in August 2005 is spent for the replacement, refurbishment, repair and maintenance of City-owned storm drain facilities pursuant to the budget adopted by the City Council each fiscal year. The Oversight Committee shall annually review a comparison of budget v. actual accounting and Staff's recommendation regarding the User Fee rate for the forthcoming year. The Oversight Committee shall forward its User Fee rate recommendation to the City Council prior to the annual public hearing expected to be conducted in June each year. Unlike other advisory boards that meet monthly, the Oversight Committee will hold evening meetings once or twice a month between April and June each year.

The five member Finance Advisory Committee provides citizen input to the City Council regarding financial matters of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes. The Committee reviews short and long-term financial information of the City and other financial issues as assigned by the City Council. The Committee may advise the City Council on matters such as the City's financial condition and economic development and recommends specific areas for review to the City Council. The work plan for the Finance Advisory Committee for 2011-12 will include a review of the 2012 Five-Year Financial Model. Upon completing review assignments, the Committee may provide its comments and recommendations to the City Council. The Committee will also receive a presentation of the City's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) prepared annually, including the annual independent audit report. The Committee meets on an as-needed basis, as determined by the annual work plan.

Those interested in applying must submit an application to the City Clerk's Office by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 6, 2012. To be considered for appointment, an applicant must be a resident of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes. ### CONSTRUCTION COMPLETE ON VIA CANADA STORM DRAIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT


Construction crews have substantially completed the Via Canada /Via Velardo storm drain improvement project. The work to install two new catch basin inlets and underground reinforced concrete pipe to the existing County drain was completed just prior to Thanksgiving. The inlets have performed well during the periodic rain events during the last couple of weeks.



### UPDATE ON ARTERIAL ROADS REHAB PROJECT

The construction work for the Palos Verdes Drive West/Palos Verdes Drive South Arterial Roads Rehabilitation Project began last week. The crews focused on saw-cutting operations in preparation for the concrete repair and improvement areas and bus pad installations. Work was not performed on Thursday, November 24<sup>th</sup>, or Friday, November 25<sup>th</sup>, in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday, and resumed on Monday, November 28<sup>th</sup>. The concrete bus pad installations are being performed this week in localized areas along Palos Verdes Drive South and therefore delays to traffic are anticipated to be minor. **PASEO DEL MAR EDITORIAL (See next page)**

An editorial ran in the Peninsula News Thanksgiving day titled “First, *Paseo del Mar*, it could happen here”. The City’s Geologist, Jim Lancaster has assured staff that there are no direct correlations between the Paseo del Mar landslide and the Portuguese Bend landslide. A section of the roadway was buttressed last year to help minimize roadway movement, the drainage system south of the roadway is being repaired to minimize runoff intrusion into the landslide and staff is looking at the feasibility of reestablishing a drainage system to convey runoff from Paintbrush Canyon to the downstream drainage system which should help slow movement within the landslide complex. Staff is eagerly looking forward to working with the City Council on this important issue which could be discussed thoroughly at a future workshop at the direction of the Council.

## First, Paseo del Mar; it could happen here

Many Peninsula residents have been following the movement of Paseo del Mar in San Pedro for months before its collapse Sunday. The collapse didn't come as a surprise really, but it was shocking nonetheless. What was once a beautiful, scenic coastal road is now a broken, mangled mess along the side and at the bottom of the cliff. How many of us have driven that portion of the road during warm spring and summer days, and enjoyed the view of the setting sun?

The collapse of Paseo del Mar is a reminder that what happened in our neighboring city has happened and will most likely happen to us again. It's a terrifying thought, but, as we all know, we have unstable ground beneath our feet.

Our local city councils and staffs are paying close attention to our coastline, particularly the hotspots near Bluff Cove, Portuguese Bend, and Tarapaca

and San Ramon canyons. Palos Verdes Estates recently completed a major project, but there are still others. The city of Rancho Palos Verdes is currently working to secure funds, some \$20 million, to begin work on the San Ramon Storm Drain Improvement and Emergency Slope Stabilization Project.

City staff has completed a review of the project's initial study and mitigating measures for the improvements and

stabilizations. Upon their review, staffers found no significant effect on the environment and have prepared a mitigating negative declaration.

RPV City Council will now consider the MND and a coastal permit, which moves the repair project to its next steps. (The documents, by the way, are available for public view and the city will take public comment on them through Dec. 16.) From previous com-

ments, the city hopes to have the project ready to go so the work can begin by the time the state and federal money is secured.

One of the talking points during the RPV City Council race was the repair of the Portuguese Bend area. During his campaign, candidate Ken Dyda said if we didn't fund solutions for PV Drive South in the Portuguese Bend we'd be calling it "Portuguese Bend Bay." After witnessing Paseo del Mar's plunge to the sea, his comments should be ringing in our ears.

The *News* hopes that as the newly elected council members take their seats and current councils reorganize their leadership, that the safety of the residents living along the Peninsula's gorgeous coast and that of those who traverse its coastal road, for business or pleasure, are the top priority.


