PUBLIC OUTREACH TO GARDENERS AND LANDSCAPERS

Staff has mailed the attached "A Gardener's Guide to Recycling Green Waste" to various gardening and landscaping services and companies that operate in the City. These companies service single-family residences, multi family complexes, and/or businesses. This helpful guide was prepared by EDCO and is in both English and Spanish to reach a larger audience. The guide lists the acceptable recyclable green waste material. In addition, it also lists items that should not be placed for green waste recycling in order to avoid possible contamination and the rejection of the green waste material.

UPDATE ON RESIDENTIAL ROADWAY REHAB PROJECT

The contractor crews worked on chip seal repairs, including a few cul-de-sacs, and completing the slurry over the chip seal in select areas over the last week in the Whitley Collins and Island View areas. Additional crews are working to complete the last of the sidewalk repairs, curb ramp, and gutter work in these areas. The next steps will be to replace the signs, striping, curb markings, and pavement markings that were removed due to the construction. The re-painting of house numbers on the curbs of the properties within the project area is also included in the City's project and is scheduled to be performed in this area in the last week of October. Residents are alerted to not accept offers from solicitors to paint the addresses on the curbs. Preparatory work (sidewalk, gutters, etc.) for the resurfacing is also beginning in some of the residential neighborhoods off of Palos Verdes Drive East and the Miraleste area this week. Residents are encouraged to visit the Public Works Department's webpage on the City's website for updated maps and notices as they become available. Staff is very appreciative of the continued patience and cooperation received by the residents in these areas.



Green Recycling Cart for Green Waste



Use your green collection cart to separate landscape waste and other organic materials for collection each week on your scheduled EDCO service day.

Residential customers use a GREEN 96-gallon green-waste cart, or a smaller size for residents with space or storage constraints, to dispose of their yard waste. Collect yard-waste material directly into the green cart (*please do not use plastic bags*).

Please note that up to two additional green yard-waste carts are available at no additional cost. Residents with carts beyond three may request additional green-waste carts for a nominal monthly fee.

Residents may bundle tree branches or brush with twine and place bundles next to cart. Bundles should not exceed 4' x 18" in dimension and weigh no more than 50 pounds. Residents may place out unlimited tied bundles at no additional cost.

What Happens to Green Waste?

Recycled green waste is primarily used for ADC (Alternative Daily Cover) at landfills and can also be used to produce compost.

What Can Be Recycled?

RECYCLABLE GREEN WASTE INCLUDES:

- Grass clippings
- Brush
- Weeds
- Hedge trimmings
- Branches
- Leaves
- Palm fronds
- Ice plant
- Ivy
- Flowers
- Halloween pumpkins
- Holiday trees (flocked trees are OK)
- Untreated and non-lead based painted wood



Keep It Clean!

Please keep contaminants out to help ensure green-waste material is able to be recycled. Please do **NOT** place any of the following in your green colored green-waste cart:

- NO Treated Wood or Lumber
- NO Dirt, Rocks, Asphalt, Concrete or Sand
- NO Trash

PRE-QUALIFICATION FORMS AVAILABLE FOR FUTURE TENANTS OF THE MIRANDELA SENIOR AFFORDABLE APARTMENTS

Construction on the Mirandela Senior Affordable Apartments is getting closer to completion. In fact, the completion date has moved up from February 2011 to December 2010. Anticipating the upcoming opening, the property owner, AMCAL Multi-housing will be using a leasing agent, Western Senior Housing to manage tenant occupancy.

Western Senior Housing has recently made available "Pre-qualification Forms" as a first step in finding qualified tenants to lease the new 33 affordable units. As approved, the 33 units are available only to persons 62 years of age and older. Depending upon the number of occupants per unit, a maximum household income ranging from approximately \$17,400 to \$44,760 will be required. It is expected that rents will vary from \$335 to \$1,066 per month depending upon total household income and number of occupants per unit.

Staff has issued a Press Release to the Peninsula News that will note the availability of the Pre-qualification Forms to the public through Western Senior Housing. Additionally, Western Senior Housing has sent the Forms to all of those persons that have expressed interest in leasing a unit since the project began construction. Staff will also be posting a note on the City's website with information on how to obtain a Form from Western Senior Housing.

Upon receiving completed Forms from interested parties, Western Senior Housing will ensure that the future tenants qualify for a unit, conduct interviews of the potential tenant, and enter into the lease agreements with each Tenant.

1. COASTAL PERMIT, VARIANCE, HEIGHT VARIATION, GRADING PERMIT & SITE PLAN REVIEW (CASE NO. ZON2009-00403): 86 Yacht Harbor Drive / Pesusich (LM)

Request: A request to construct a 356 square foot addition to the existing single-story residence, an 84 square foot balcony, and a 404 square foot addition and roof deck above the existing detached garage. The applicant is also requesting to legalize a 300 square foot carport that was previously converted to habitable space along the northeast portion of the existing residence. The application requires a Height Variation to allow the existing residence to exceed 16'-0" from the highest grade elevation. A Variance is required to allow reduced setbacks, development over an extreme slope (35% or greater), construction of more than 250 square feet within the City's Coastal Setback Zone, an addition over the detached garage exceeding 16'-0" in height, construction of a roof deck over the detached garage, and a non-conforming lot coverage of 65%. The project also includes the construction of three (3) garden walls, one 5'-0" tall retaining wall along the south property line, and one (1) 5'-0" tall retaining wall along the north side of the residence to accommodate a new planter and stairs.

Request: A request to construct a 5,909ft² (5,216ft² habitable space & 693ft² garage) split-level residence with 3,880yd³ of related grading and install photovoltaic solar panels on a vacant lot.

Recommendation: Adopt P.C. Resolution No. 2010-__; thereby approving, with conditions, a Grading Permit and Site Plan Review (Case No. ZON2010-00172).
