## CITY MANAGER

- PVPUSD Energy Conservation Facilities Project: On December 15<sup>th</sup>, representatives of all four (4) Peninsula cities, the Palos Verdes Homes Association and the Rolling Hills Community Association met with PVPUSD Staff to discuss the proposed installation of freestanding solar panels at 16 PVPUSD campuses. City and Association representatives all strongly recommended that the District erect silhouettes of the proposed panel installations as a part of its public outreach process, rather than relying upon photographic simulations. City Staff also agreed to provide the District with mailing lists for property owners within a 500-foot radius of each affected campus to assist with public notification. PVPUSD expects to hold six (6) public outreach meetings at various locations in late January and early February.
- Filming Activity on Sunday, December 20<sup>th</sup>: There is filming activity scheduled for Sunday, December 20<sup>th</sup> at Point Vicente Park/Civic Center and in the public right-of-way of Crest Rd., just west of Hawthorne Blvd. A commercial shoot will set up base camp at Point Vicente Park/Civic Center from 5:00 AM to 7:00 PM, and the commercial will be filming at the Chase Bank branch at 29941 Hawthorne Blvd. On-street parking along the north side of Crest Rd. will be temporarily prohibited on Sunday, but public sidewalks adjacent to the bank will remain accessible to pedestrians. ## FINANCE

- Recruitment for Deputy Director of Finance: As most already know, the Deputy Director of Finance, Kathryn Downs, accepted the position of Finance Director with the City of Carson. For the past 15 years, Kat (as she likes to be called) has been a tremendous asset to the City of RPV. Her impact and accomplishments cannot be overstated, and she will be sorely missed. Kat's last day will be January 4<sup>th</sup>. With that said, the City has begun the recruitment process and first review of applications will be tentatively performed the week of December 14<sup>th</sup>. Finance is hoping to have the position filled by the end of January.

## PUBLIC WORKS

- Public Works Encroachment Permit Report: The Public Works Department is responsible for control of work performed within the City Public "Rights of Way". An Encroachment Permit is required to insure that any applicant working in our streets or parkways is properly licensed, insured and in compliance with the NPDES requirements. - New Bus Shelter Trash/Recycling Cluster: Staff has begun deployment of new trash and recycling clusters at various bus shelters throughout the City. We hope that these larger size containers will help prevent trash overflow and discourage contamination of recyclables with trash.



- Maintenance: Maintenance and Parks staff setup and participated in the second volunteer sandbag filling day in the Corp Yard. Thirty volunteers filled approximately 1000 sandbags in preparation for winter storm flood control. The playing field at Hesse Park was re-seeded to reestablish a uniform playing surface. The field will be closed through February for establishment of the turf. The installation of a catch basin and berm at Ryan Park was completed. The system was installed to prevent overtopping of the swale at the foot of the hill during heavy rain events. The berm will be seeded in the coming week. Maintenance personnel removed approximately 80' of guard rail on PVDE, which was damaged in a hit and run accident. The guard rail was apparently run over by a combination vehicle trailer. Quotes are being gathered for the replacement of the guardrail.
- Public Works Emergency Management Group Workshop: Staff attended a half day workshop with a newly formed Public Works Emergency Management Group initiated by LA County's Department of Public Works. The well attended workshop addressed topics relating to the upcoming winter storms predicted to be more severe than normal due to the El Nino effect. Notable topics included an update on the developing El Nino climate event by a NOAA meteorologist, preparations being made by the County at its facilities, communications protocols being employed by the County, mutual aid along the County and 87 of its municipalities and the FEMA Flood Insurance program. County has also made available informative multi-language brochures to assist residents with preparations, which will be available at the public works counter and is available on the City's website.

- Roan Road Storm Drain Rehabilitation Project: This Project is located at the end of the Roan Road cul-de-sac. The scope includes improvement of the existing CMP pipe, installation of an additional Catch Basin, Installation of CIPP (Cured in place pipe lining), installation of Rip-Rap at the bottom of the creek and restoration of the site. This week's work included removing and replacing curb and gutter and installation of a new storm drain inlet.



- Organics Recycling Assistance at Trump National: Trump National management contacted Staff and Waste Management (their hauler) to assist them in complying with the upcoming Mandatory Commercial Organics Recycling regulations. On Monday 12/14/15 a site visit was performed and Waste Management has scheduled follow up action including educating kitchen and maintenance staff.
- Upcoming Southern California Edison (SCE) work: Southern California Edison (SCE) will be performing repair work to their vault equipment on Northbay Road located near the Ridgecrest Intermediate School starting this Saturday, December 19<sup>th</sup>, and continuing to the end of December. This work was scheduled to coincide with the winter break so as not to impact the normal school operations at Ridgecrest

Intermediate School. Work will not be performed on Sundays, December 24<sup>th</sup> – December 25<sup>th</sup>, or December 31<sup>st</sup> – January 1<sup>st</sup>, in observance of the holidays. As part of this work, two scheduled power outages are planned for December 21<sup>st</sup> and December 28<sup>th</sup>, affecting approximately less than 20 customers. A Public Works Department Inspector will be onsite monitoring this project throughout its duration to ensure that City requirements are adhered to. - Ryan Park Drainage: Improvements at Ryan Park that included establishing a drainage collection system along the south boundary of Ryan Park, south of the baseball field have been completed. The drainage improvements will help manage runoff during large storms that can overwhelm the private v-ditch drainage system located in the rear yards of the homes on Via La Cresta Ct. and Vallon Drive. The drainage improvements are intended to intercept runoff and deliver it directly to an existing drainage system, bypassing the v-ditch system which will minimize the threat of overwhelming the private system during larger storms. ## COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

- Peafowl Trapping Program Update: The Council-adopted Peafowl Management Plan indicates that seasonal trapping of peahen will take place July 15<sup>th</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>, while peacocks (males) can be trapped all year long, if deemed necessary by the City. As reported at the August 4<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting, since trapping commenced late this year, combined with the success of the program, the City intends to continue

trapping male peacocks into January 2016.

- Building Permit Inspections during Holiday Break: Although City Hall will be closed between Christmas and New Year's Day, the City's Building & safety Division will provide permit inspection services on Monday, December 28 and Wednesday, December 30. While overall construction in the City substantially decreases during this holiday period, some construction work still occurs. Having City inspectors provide a couple days of inspections during this period, allows the construction jobs that remain active to continue without a prolonged delay.
- Beehives in Malaga Canyon: A resident alerted the City with concerns that active bee hives had been placed on what appeared to be City owned property in Malaga Canyon next to the Pacific Unitarian Church off of Montemalga Road. City Staff confirmed that the bee hives were indeed on City owned property and Staff was able to track down the owner of the bee hives. The bee hive owner didn't realize that he had placed the bee hives on City property and will be relocating the bee hives to his own property in the next 2 weeks. The City's code allows the keeping of bee hives on residential properties for non-commercial purposes.
- PC Meeting: The Regular Meeting of the Planning Commission scheduled for Tuesday, December 22, 2015 has been cancelled due to a lack of a quorum since there are no items scheduled for this agenda. The next Regular Meeting of the Planning Commission will be held on Tuesday, January 12, 2016 at 7:00 P.M. at the Fred Hesse Community Park.


