Public Safety & Ring.Com Security Products: As part of the City's updated Public Safety Strategic Plan, one of the solutions the City continues to work toward is utilizing technology to make neighborhoods safer. The City and Sheriff's Department have negotiated a subsidy with Ring.com to provide RPV residents with a discount. The device limit for Ring's discount is three units per household. In addition, the City Council has allocated \$100,000 toward one \$50 incentive per household for this public safety program. The program will run until July 31, 2017, or until funding runs out.

On Saturday, July 8, 2017, the City hosted a Ring meet and greet event at Hesse Park to provide RPV residents an opportunity to learn more about the available devices and to purchase devices on site from Ring representatives. Over 200 residents attended the event throughout the day. RPV residents interested in purchasing devices may still do so and are required to complete the Resident General Release Agreement and provide proof of residency such as a copy of a driver's license. Residents are asked to return the completed form and proof of residency to Administrative Analyst Jacqueline Ruiz via email jruiz@rpvca.gov in order to receive the promotion codes to purchase the available devices online at Ring's website.

FINANCE

PUBLIC WORKS

Wireless Telecommunications Facilities Permit: Permits were processed for four proposed cell sites, mock-up purposes only. Public Hearings for two specific sites is scheduled for the July 25th planning Commission Meeting.

Miraleste Drive Arterial Rehabilitation Project: A kickoff meeting was held last week for the project. The work will include resurfacing Miraleste Drive from 1st Street to Palos Verdes Drive East. It is scheduled to start on July 17th.

Pedestrian Safe Bus Stop Linkage on Hawthorne Blvd. Project: California Landscape & Design continues making improvements to the sidewalk and driveway approaches along Hawthorne Blvd. southbound from Crest Rd. to PVDW. The driveways at the following locations will be completed this week: Ralph's entrance, PV Victoria Apartments, Ryan Park (bottom entrance). Work will be conducted Monday through Friday from 8 am to 4 pm. Please watch for and obey the traffic control signs and the flagman's direction for your safety, and the safety of the workers. SCE Night Work on Hawthorne Blvd. by Blackhorse Rd.: SCE has requested permission from the City to conduct night work to replace two power poles along southbound Hawthorne Blvd. on July 12, 2017 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. There will be one lane opened at all times. Please watch for and obey the traffic control signs and the flagman's direction for your safety, and the safety of the workers. For more information, please contact the Public Works Department at (310) 544-5252.

Infrastructure Management Advisory Committee: On Thursday, July 13, 2017 the IMAC will meet at 7:00 pm at Hesse Park for its regularly scheduled monthly meeting. At that meeting, the Committee will receive a presentation from Public Works on the status of various projects as well as hear an informative presentation from representatives of HR Green on Digital Cities and Services. The Committee will also continue discussions about their sub-committees, vice-chair selection and annual work plan. The public is encouraged to attend.

Residential Street Rehabilitation Project for Area 7: The design includes roadway rehabilitation for Area 7 (neighborhoods off of PVDE from PVDS up to and near Miraleste Drive) based on the Pavement Management Program recommendations. Construction bids have been received and will be presented to council this month. Construction is anticipated to begin in late summer 2017.

Residential Street Rehabilitation Project for Area 8: The design will include roadway rehabilitation for Area 8 (neighborhoods near the northern end of PVDE) based on the Pavement Management Program recommendations. Design is underway and construction is anticipated to begin in late summer 2018.

Storm Drain Deficiency Improvement Program FY 16-17: The design phase is completed for the first year of the 10-year program outlined in the Master Plan of Drainage (MPD).

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Colich and Sons has been approved by Council to perform construction services. Construction is anticipated to begin in August 2017.

Maintenance: Maintenance vendors replaced concrete street, curb and sidewalk sections which were damaged by a motor vehicle accident in June, on Calle Entradero and Calle Viento. Work to repair the irrigation system, trail, fence and landscaping is scheduled over the next two weeks.

Maintenance staff provided support for the City's Fourth of July and Shakespeare in the Park events.

Maintenance staff and vendors in coordination with Rec & Parks and PVPLC are repairing storm damaged trails and roads in the Portuguese Bend Reserve. This work is expected to continue for several weeks and be completed in early August.

Public Works Encroachment Permit Report – June 2017: The Public Works Department is responsible for control of work performed within the City Public "Rights of Way". An Encroachment Permit is required to insure that any applicant working in our streets or parkways is properly licensed, insured, and in compliance with the NPDES requirements.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Garage Fire at 27108 Freeport Road: On July 7, 2017, the LA County Fire Department responded to a house fire at 27108 Freeport Road. According to the Fire Department, the structure fire was started by a vehicle parked inside that had just been serviced for a check engine light. There were no reported injuries other than to a firefighter who sustained a burn to the arm. The City’s Building Official inspected the structure and found that the home had experienced only minor damage but the garage sustained extensive damage and will need to be rebuilt. The structure was “yellow tagged” restricting access to the garage. Pursuant to Section 17.84.060(2) of the RPVMC, the damaged structure is allowed to be rebuilt in the same footprint and height, and Section 17.78.010(F) allows, among other things, that the City waive “any permit or application fee” provided that the homeowner demonstrates that their insurance policy does not cover said fees. Staff will be working closely with the property owner through the rebuild process.



LAX Roundtable Update: The City of Rancho Palos Verdes is part of the LAX Community Noise Roundtable that was created to reduce and mitigate adverse aircraft noise impacts on nearby cities. The Roundtable meets on the second Wednesday of every odd numbered month at 7:00 p.m. Citizens of Rancho Palos Verdes are invited to attend the next Roundtable meeting on Wednesday July 12, 2017 in the Clifton A. Moore Administration Building at 1 World Way, Los Angeles, CA 90045 (see attached Roundtable Parking Map).

General Plan Update - Technical Studies: On July 25, 2017, the Planning Commission will be presented with the updated Traffic, Noise and Air Quality/Green House Gas Technical Studies that were prepared by the City's consultant, Environmental Science Associates (ESA). Should the Commission accept the Technical Studies, the data will be used to update the City's General Plan and prepare the related environmental document. The technical studies are available for viewing on the City's 'General Plan Update' webpage: <http://www.rpvca.gov/356/General-Plan-Update>.

Crestridge (Sol y Mar) Update: The May 17, 2017 Administrative Report noted that the Pli-Dek surface and color coating on Building Nos. 7 & 14, and the roof tile blend on Building No. 7 were not installed per City approvals. The Developer has removed and replaced the respective Pli-Dek surface and roof tiles. Staff conducted an inspection and determined that the replaced Pli-Dek surfaces and roof tiles are in substantial conformance to City approvals (see attached photographs). Staff notified the nearby residents of its determination on June 27, 2017.

Poke Me Restaurant Grand Opening at Golden Cove: Grand opening ceremonies will occur this weekend to celebrate the opening of the new Poke Me restaurant at the Golden Cove Shopping Center. Shakespeare by the Sea Wrap up: Over 600 people attended the annual Shakespeare by the Sea performance of the classic comedy, Taming of the Shrew, on the upper field at Hesse Park last Sunday, July 9th. Many attendees came early and enjoyed a picnic dinner before the performance, then settled in for a warm summer evening of theater under the stars!



The facilities are rented this week for thirteen indoor recreation classes, four non-profit group rentals, two Peninsula Seniors activities, and two private rentals.

Ladera Linda Park: The facilities are rented this week for four indoor recreation classes.

Ryan Park: The facilities are rented this week for three outdoor recreation classes, three youth sports league rentals, and two private rentals.

PVIC and Docents: The Sunset Room will be rented this Wednesday night for a non-profit group meeting, followed by two wedding receptions this weekend, Friday and Saturday. The Saturday renters will also be renting the amphitheater for their wedding ceremony. The docents are leading two tour groups at PVIC on Tuesday and Wednesday.

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REACH Therapeutic Recreation Program: On Sunday night, July 9th, REACH participants enjoyed the Shakespeare by the Sea performance of the Taming of the Shrew at Hesse Park. On Monday night, REACH participants met outside at the picnic tables and enjoyed a tasty chili dinner, followed by some outdoor games. On Wednesday evening, REACH will head to Pieology for pizza, then enjoy some bocce ball fun. The busy week wraps up on Saturday with a fun trip to the annual Lotus Festival in Echo Park.

Palos Verdes Nature Preserve June 2017 Activity Summary:

Meetings:

Monthly Preserve Management Meeting (June 1st): PVPLC staff, Recreation & Parks and Public Works staff met to discuss maintenance and operational management projects and priorities.

Volunteer Trail Watch Coordination Meeting (June 28th): PVPLC staff, Volunteer Trail Watch leaders, City staff and L. A. Co. Sheriff deputies met to discuss public use, maintenance observations as well as to coordinate efforts.

Public Forum (June 28th): PVPLC staff and City staff met with members of the public to brief them and answer questions on current projects, recent activities and future opportunities in the Preserve.

Preserve/Open Space Staff Activities:

Public Contacts: the Preserve Staff encountered many people while conducting trail patrols (Abalone Cove Reserve figures are not included for June).

Public Contacts: 1089 (hikers -- 914; dog walkers -- 119; bike users -- 54; equestrians -- 2)

Public Use Issues: 24 (including dogs off leash -- 7; people off trail -- 17)

Public Information: 4 (sharing Preserve/Interpretive information -- 4)

Public Safety: 12 (patrons requesting direction -- 12).

Maintenance and Operations: OSM and Abalone Cove Shoreline Park Staffs removed numerous bags of litter picked up while hiking the trails. Their activities in June included:

Filiorum Reserve – picked up excessive litter behind the steel fence along Crenshaw Blvd. at the Rattlesnake Trailhead, cleaned graffiti on a rock along Rattlesnake Tr. and from a wooden trail support on Kelvin Canyon Trail.

Portuguese Bend Reserve – cleaned graffiti off the water tank along Burma Rd., cleaned graffiti from the black pipe along Peppertree Tr., cleaned graffiti from the toilets on Burma Rd., repaired the stake & rope fence along Toyon Tr., repaired over 130 yards of erosion

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gully in lower Vanderlip Tr. and re-opened it for public use, installed trail map closure signs, repaired the Toyon Tr. irrigation tank, filled in a hole in Panorama Tr., filled in the sink hole in the PV Dr. South access, reset a loose sign post along Ishibashi Tr., delivered rock to the Vanderlip Trailhead for repair work, installed a sign on Paintbrush Tr. that warns users that Rim Tr. is closed, trimmed overhanging branches along Burma Rd. near Ailor Tr., installed traffic cones to warn patrons of gullies in upper Peppertree Tr. and re-opened upper Peppertree & western Ishibashi Farm Trails.

San Ramon Reserve – picked up lots of litter from the three turnouts along PV Drive East.

Three Sisters Reserve – picked up numerous doggie bags left at the McCarrell Canyon Trailhead.

Vicente Bluffs Reserve – disposed of large debris and trash hidden in the bushes along the beach east of the Toveemor Trailhead and disposed of 23 trash bags of debris picked up by volunteers at Pelican Cove Beach.



Open Space Management is coordinating with the Information Technology Department to utilize G.I.S. in mapping maintenance features on Preserve trails.

Open Space Management regularly checks on closures of the Preserve Trails resulting from storm damage. The following trails are currently closed in the Portuguese Bend Reserve: lower Peppertree, Sandbox, the eastern segment of Ishibashi Farm, Rim's lower portion and the lower segment of Klondike Canyon. Sunset Trail in the Ocean Trails Reserve is also closed until repairs can be made. In the Abalone Cove Reserve, the following trails are closed: Cave, Cliffside, Inspiration Point and Sacred Cove View.

Preserve/Open Space Management cooperates closely with the Public Works Department to discover, submit and complete work orders to repair problems and improve conditions in the Preserve. In June, Public Works responded to service requests to repair the wooden and steel fences along the trails in Vicente Bluffs, to trim vegetation along Pacifica Del Mar and along Seascape Tr., to replace a missing road sign along upper PV Drive East in San Ramon, to replace drain caps & repair a large rut along Golden Cove Tr., to repair broken sprinkler heads along Calle Entradero, to replace a missing No Beach Access sign on Seascape Tr., to install a gate chain at the PV Dr. South access to Ishibashi Farm Tr., to repair the Ladera Linda yard gate, to deliver dirt for Vanderlip Tr. repair, to replace a missing No Smoking sign at Cool Overlook in Forrestal Reserve, to repair cracks in the sidewalk and the broken steel fence near the Rattlesnake Trailhead.

The City's graffiti contractor responded to 7 incidents of tagging that were reported by Open Space Management. Thank you Public Works and thank you to the Land Conservancy's Volunteer Trail Watch for being our eyes in the Preserve to help report maintenance issues.


