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## **CITY MANAGER**

**General Municipal Election:** The City of Rancho Palos Verdes will hold its General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 for two City Councilmember seats for a full term of three years. Those interested in running for office must be a registered voter and a resident of the City. The nomination period begins Monday, July 17 and closes Friday, August 11 at 4:30 p.m. Nomination papers may be obtained by contacting the City Clerk. **Public Safety & Ring.Com Security Products:** As part of the City's updated Public Safety Strategic Plan, one of the solutions the City continues to work toward is utilizing technology to make neighborhoods safer. The City and Sheriff's Department have negotiated a subsidy with Ring.com to provide RPV residents with a discount. Ring will provide a \$50 subsidy on the Ring video doorbell (original version) and Stick Up Cam and a \$175 subsidy on the Ring video doorbell pro version. The device limit for Ring's discount is three units per household. In addition to Ring's discount, the City will provide one \$50 incentive on the Ring video doorbell or the Stick up Cam. The City incentive is limited as the City Council allocated \$100,000 for the program and based on a first come, first served basis. The discount and incentive provide a significant savings as the products are regularly the following prices: Ring Video doorbell (original version) and Stick Up Cam are regularly \$179 each and the Ring Video Doorbell Pro is regularly \$249.

RPV residents interested in purchasing products are required to complete a Resident General Release Agreement which is available online at the City website <http://www.rpvca.gov/DocumentCenter/View/10102>. Return the completed form to Administrative Analyst Jacqueline Ruiz at [jruiz@rpvca.gov](mailto:jruiz@rpvca.gov) in order to receive the promotion codes and additional information about how to purchase products.

**Update on SB 649:** On July 12<sup>th</sup>, the Assembly Communications and Conveyance Committee passed SB 649 (see attached League of California Cities update). The bill now heads for the Assembly Appropriations Committee.

**Notice of Extended-Hours Construction in Rolling Hills Estates:** On July 17<sup>th</sup>, Staff received the attached notice from the City of Rolling Hills Estates regarding a Noise Variance request for the Bank of America branch located at 27411 Hawthorne Blvd. The bank is asking permission for extended overnight and weekend construction hours from Saturday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> through Labor Day, Monday September 4<sup>th</sup>. Comments on this proposed permit must be submitted to the City of Rolling Hills Estates by Friday, July 21<sup>st</sup>. ## **FINANCE**

Governmental Accounting Tutorial Series (Internal Service Funds): The Internal Service Funds are used to finance and account for goods and services provided by one City department to other City departments on a cost reimbursement basis, including depreciation. The City currently has two active internal service funds.

- Equipment Replacement – to account for purchases of replacement equipment, furniture and vehicles of all City departments.
- Employee Benefits – to account for employee benefit costs for all employees charged to various City departments.

## **PUBLIC WORKS**

Wireless Telecommunications Facilities Permit: One additional permit was processed for a proposed cell site (Mock-up purposes only). There is now a total of 22 Cell-Site Mock-Ups throughout the City. The first set of Public Hearings for the sites is scheduled for the July 25th Planning Commission Meeting.

Storm Drain Point Repair: Construction is scheduled to begin this week to repair storm drain pipes at seven different locations on the east side of the city. Residents have been notified and temporary construction easements (to provide access for construction) are being finalized.

Pedestrian Safe Bus Stop Linkage on Hawthorne Blvd. Project: California Landscape & Design will be working at the signalized driveway at Ryan Park this week throughout the following week. The work will be performed on one half of the driveway first and the other half next week, however, the entire driveway will be opened during the weekend. Also, new sidewalk construction will start this week on the southbound of Hawthorne Blvd. south of Vallon Dr. Please watch for and obey the traffic control signs and the flagman's direction for your safety, and the safety of the workers. SCE Night Work on Hawthorne Blvd. by Blackhorse Rd.: SCE submitted a request to conduct night work to replace a power pole along Hawthorne Blvd. southbound on August 8, 2017 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. There will be a one lane opened at all times. For more information, please contact the Public Works Department at (310) 544-5252.

SCE Night Work on Crenshaw Blvd. by Silver Spur Rd.: SCE submitted a request to conduct night work to replace two power poles along Crenshaw Blvd. southbound on August 10, 2017 from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. There will be one lane opened at all times. For more information, please contact the Public Works Department at (310) 544-5252.

Traffic Signs Inventory: KOA has completed the sign inventory of all City owned signs throughout the City. They will also be performing night time inspections on all regulatory and warning signs to assess their reflectivity. The project also includes the development of

a sign inventory database that can be incorporated into GIS and Cityworks that will allow better sign management and maintenance in the future.

Maintenance: Maintenance personnel poured the footing for the new spring ride toy purchased for installation at Ryan Park. The toy will be installed once the foundation has had a chance to cure for several weeks. The ride is expected to be ready for use by August 1st.

## **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

RPV Estates Community Association's Appeal of the View Preservation Permit Has Been Withdrawn: On July 5, 2017, Staff reported that the Rancho Palos Verdes Estates Community Association (HOA) filed a timely appeal of the Planning Commission's adoption of P.C. Resolution No. 2017-17, requiring the removal of Pine tree and the future maintenance of other foliage located within HOA's common area. According to the Conditions of Approval, the Applicant at 59 Paseo de Castana had 30-days from the date the Commission adopted the resolution to submit a certificate accepting the Conditions of Approval, otherwise the approval becomes null and void. The Applicant did not submit this form by the deadline of Friday, July 14<sup>th</sup>. In the absence of the said form, the Commission's decision is now null and void, and unenforceable. The appeal to the City Council submitted by the HOA has been administratively withdrawn as there is no longer a decision to appeal. The HOA will receive a full refund of the appeal fee. Any future requests to restore views will require the processing and analysis of a new application.

9<sup>th</sup> Annual Wine & Beer Festival at Trump National: It's that time of the year again! The 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Wine & Beer Festival benefitting the Palos Verdes Peninsula Chamber of Commerce is scheduled to take place at Trump National and Founder's Park on Sunday, August 20, 2017. Staff is processing a Special Event Permit and a Special Use Permit for the event. The attached Public Notice is being mailed to property owners within 500' of the Trump National Golf Club property. It should be noted that the Public Notice inadvertently noted that this is the 8<sup>th</sup> annual event. A revised notice will not be distributed because the project description cited in the Notice remains accurate.

Trump National – Temporary Closure of the Sunset Trail: In March, the Sunset Trail (beach access trail located west of Founder's Park) was temporary closed due to significant trail damage resulting from this past winter's rain events. The Trump organization will begin repairing the trail, including portions of the existing fencing, this week. The repair work is anticipated to take 8-10 days to complete and signs will be posted alerting the public of the temporary trail closure. While Sunset Trail will be temporarily closed during the repair activity, all other trails will remain open to the public.

Green Hills Applications: On May 1, 2017, Green Hills submitted two separate requests to 1) expand the existing information booth at the entrance from 72.5ft<sup>2</sup> to 123.25ft<sup>2</sup> in size and 2) construct a 119.5ft<sup>2</sup> bathroom addition at the center of the existing Administration Building. Pursuant to Council-adopted Condition No. 2(a) 2, these two requests are being processed as a Site Plan Review for consideration by the Director. The Director's decision is appealable to the Planning Commission. A copy of the public notices and submitted

LAX Roundtable Update: At the July 12, 2017 Roundtable meeting, the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) Staff presented a preliminary analysis of aircraft activity over the Palos Verdes Peninsula (see attachment). Since its implementation of the new satellite navigation system Metroplex last spring, LAWA discovered that the FAA Staff has been directing the turbo propeller carrier, Mokulele, to fly below the 5,000-foot altitude restriction. LAWA explained that the FAA direction was due to safety reasons as Mokulele flies significantly slower than other aircraft. In addition, FAA have directed jets from its departure route that has resulted in flights over the City. City Staff expressed strong objection to this. LAWA will present more information at a Roundtable meeting and City staff will provide an update in the Weekly Report.

# Assembly Communications and Conveyance Committee Ignores City Officials' Opposition and Passes SB 649

July 13, 2017

A growing coalition of community leaders and local elected officials vowed to continue their fight to defeat what the *Los Angeles Times* called “an audacious power grab” by telecom giants that will undermine local control, and transfer hundreds of millions of dollars from key government services to the bottom line of the world’s largest wireless companies.

SB 649 (Hueso) is backed by AT&T, Verizon, T-Mobile and Sprint, and is opposed by a broad coalition of local leaders including the League of California Cities, the California State Association of Counties, and the Rural County Representatives of California, in addition to 34 counties and over 215 cities.

The Assembly Communications and Conveyance Committee took up SB 649 on Wednesday, July 12, and passed the measure 10-0 with three members not voting even as the coalition of opposition continues to grow.

The League was represented by several speakers in the committee hearing. League Legislative Representative Rony Berdugo testified first and reminded the committee that SB 649 forces cities and counties to lease out public property, eliminates the ability of local governments to lease their property at fair market rate by capping that lease at \$250 for an attachment charge on municipal property and by eliminating discretionary permits, it eliminates public input and the discretion of cities to impose conditions for public benefit.

Several city officials traveled to Sacramento yesterday to voice their opposition to the committee including:

- Pasadena City Council Member Margaret McAustin;
- Norco City Council Member Kevin Bash;
- San Francisco City/County Planner Omar Masry;
- Apple Valley Council Member Barb Stanton; and
- Eastvale Council Member Clint Lorimore.

SB 649 would incentivize companies to terminate their current agreements and unilaterally replace them with the reduced regulatory and fee structures. This would dramatically cut the fees companies must pay to cities for use of public property and allow them to place equipment wherever they want on public assets. It adds millions to telecom company profits, while exempting them from having to spend

money on expanded wireless access for underserved communities.

In a press release sent following the hearing, League President and Lodi City Council Member remarked: “This bill shifts power and resources from local governments and our residents to the telecommunications industry. This bad bill would render local residents and municipalities powerless to determine where and how public infrastructure is used by this industry as it seeks to add tens of thousands of new cell phone equipment to street lights, utility poles and public buildings throughout California. As local leaders we are all for progress but not at this cost.”

The measure also creates two different sets of rules – one for affluent coastal communities and another for rural and inland communities who would be rendered powerless by this legislation, and stand to lose the most under SB 649.

The Los Angeles Times, Sacramento Bee, San Jose Mercury News and San Francisco Chronicle have joined city and county officials from across the state to urge lawmakers to reject SB 649.



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

FAA voluntarily agreed to implement specific noise abatement procedures in the Southern California TRACON (SCT) Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) to minimize aircraft flying over the Palos Verdes (PV) Peninsula, as shown below:

- “Turbojet departures filed via southbound SIDs must be established on the SID or vectored to remain at least five (5) statute miles (SM) west and three (3) SM south of Palos Verdes Peninsula until leaving 13,000’ MSL.” (SCT SOP 8-3-2.a)
- “LAX Turboprop departures landing CRQ, SNA, or SAN must be vectored outside the noise dots to remain at least one (1) SM off of the Palos Verdes Peninsula shoreline.” (SCT SOP 8-3-2.f)

LAX Turboprop departures heading to eastern destinations (e.g., Phoenix or Imperial County) are directed by SCT to fly over the PV Peninsula.





## OSHNN 6 Departure




# Pre Phase 2 Metroplex Implementation

## LAX Southbound Jet Departures - 1 Month (February 2017)





## LAX Southbound Jet Departures - 1 Month (May 2017)




# Side-by-Side Comparison of Jet Departures

# Palos Verdes Peninsula – Jet Overflights

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## Preliminary Findings



- Noticeable increase in jets flying over PV Peninsula since March 2017
- Jets fly over PV Peninsula when aircraft are not following published RNAV departure procedures and are vectored (given a heading and speed) to other navigational waypoints
- Jet aircraft vectored to new waypoint CAHIL as SLI VOR waypoint is no longer included in OSHNN departure procedure; much smaller number of aircraft are vectored to SEBBY
- FAA determines whether aircraft remain on RNAV procedure (OSHNN 7) or they vector them to another waypoint (e.g., CAHIL) when required for spacing



# Turboprop Overflights – Mokulele Operations

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- Mokulele started service at LAX in June 2016 operating about 150 flights per month to Santa Maria and Imperial County with the Cessna Caravan aircraft.
- Cessna Caravan has a much lower climb rate than other turboprop aircraft such as the Embraer E120 and Beechcraft 1900.
- Based on ATC radio communications, SoCal TRACON controllers are providing an initial altitude restriction of 5,000 ft. for this aircraft.
- Mokulele's low altitude operations over PV Peninsula may be due to aircraft performance and FAA altitude restriction.

## Current and Next Steps

- LAWA recently shared these preliminary findings with FAA Southern California TRACON (SCT)
- LAWA will continue to work with FAA SCT:
  - To obtain a better understanding of these issues
  - To explore potential options in addressing these concerns
- LAWA to report back to the Roundtable with more information at a later date
