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## **CITY MANAGER**

Updates regarding SB 786 and SB 902: As the City Council may recall, the Mayor signed a letter in support of Senate Bill No. 786 (SB 786) on January 16th. SB 786 was intended to apply minimum spacing requirements between residential substance abuse rehabilitation facilities to prevent “overconcentration.” It would also make the licenses for such facilities provisional and revocable, and would increase the monetary penalties for violations of licensing and regulatory provisions. Unfortunately, SB 786 failed to pass out of the Senate Health Committee, and it died on February 1st.

In January 24th Weekly Administrative Report, Staff also reported on Senate Bill No. 902 (SB 902), which was also introduced with the intent of regulating residential substance abuse rehabilitation facilities. As originally introduced, SB 902 proposed to add regulations regarding licensure and regular inspections for these facilities. As most recently amended in the Senate Rules Committee on March 22nd, SB 902 now proposes to require criminal background checks for the applicants, managers, consultants and employees of residential substance abuse rehabilitation facilities as a condition of issuance and renewal of licenses. The City Council has not taken a position regarding SB 902.

CalWater Pipeline Project Follow-Up: On April 10th, the Rolling Hills Estates (RHE) City Council concluded its deliberations regarding the Palos Verdes Peninsula Water Reliability Project (PVPWRP). RHE Planning Staff provided additional about the acoustical shielding and aesthetics of the proposed pump station on Crenshaw Blvd. just north of Silver Spur Rd. The RHE City Council then unanimously approved the project. Construction is expected to begin this summer, and Staff will keep the City Council and residents informed about lane closures and other construction impacts as the project moves forward. ## **FINANCE**

OpenGov Visitor Data: There have been 92 visits to the site over the past 90 days with each visit lasting approximately two minutes. Based on the data, 86% of users were visiting the site for the first time and 14% were returning users. ## **PUBLIC WORKS**

PVDE Traffic & Equestrian Safety Project from Bronco Dr. to Headland Dr.: A meeting was held at City Hall, on Thursday, April 5th, discussing the proposed traffic and equestrian improvements along PVDE from Bronco Dr. to Headland Dr. The City Staff, along with the project designer, met with affected residents, presented the proposed design, and noted the concerns of the residents. The City will mark the proposed limits of the project in the coming week to try to give a better field representation of the affected areas.

Composting Workshop this Saturday: Staff is coordinating the upcoming April 14th composting workshop with the County contractor. Discounted bins will be sold after the

event (cash or check only). Similar to last year, in consideration of the instructor’s limited time availability, no immediate rebates will be offered. Rebates are available and can be processed any time the following weeks by mail, or in person.

Site Preparation for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Roundup: Maintenance staff are preparing the City Yard site for the 4/28/18 HHW event. This week Staff is meeting County and Sanitation District representatives to perform a site visit and discuss the event logistics.

Continued Earth Day/Month Events Promotions: Staff is continuing to promote the various earth day/month events via weekly ads in the PV News and Daily Breeze, monthly ads in Peninsula People and announcements via the website’s Breaking News, and Nextdoor, in addition to fliers at park facilities, and EDCO and City newsletter articles. Maintenance Activities: Public Works Maintenance Division provided oversight and monitoring of the Cell Tower inspection by American Tower. The unique approach employed the use of a Drone. The entire inspection took less than 90 minutes. This compares to two-(2) to three- (3) hour standard inspection method utilizing a man-lift. The new method touts safety as the primary reason for using drones followed by quality of inspection data compiled.





## **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

April 18th Coyote Wildlife Watch Community Workshop: As reported last week, on April 18, 2018, a Peninsula-wide community workshop hosted by the cities of Rancho Palos Verdes, Palos Verdes Estates and Rolling Hills Estates will occur at Hesse Park Community Building at 6:30 p.m. on the Coyote-Wildlife Watch program (see attached flyer). The objective of this workshop is to raise awareness of this program administered by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and to recruit volunteers to launch the program. Volunteers will be asked to attend two training courses on Saturday, April 28th and May 5th. Once trained, the Volunteers will canvass specific neighbors to educate residents on measures to keep coyotes in the canyons and out of their neighborhood. Attached is the workshop's tentative agenda (see attachment).

2018 Peafowl Census: Pursuant to the Peafowl Management Plan, each year the City is required to conduct a census survey to assess the current peafowl population trends, and based on past census reports, determine whether trapping should resume. This year's

peafowl census survey is currently underway by Wildlife Services. The census is being conducted based on two types of observations. The first is counting roosting peafowl in trees at sunrise, and the second is using a systematic grid pattern during the late afternoon to evening hours. The results of the census count will be reported to the Council in June.

Department of Animal Care and Control New Billing Methodology and Rates: The City was recently informed that the County will implement revisions to the billing methodology and rates for animal control services to contract cities. Staff will be attending a presentation by the County on April 24th and will update the Council on the salient changes.

Proposed Hydrogen Fuel Pump at Shell Gas Station: The applicant for the Shell gas station located at 28103 Hawthorne Blvd. has recently submitted a Conditional Use Permit Revision application to the Planning Division to consider installing a hydrogen fuel pump with above ground equipment at the rear of the property. The project is currently being reviewed by Staff to determine the proposal's compliance with the City's Development Code standards, including the Automotive Overlay District standards, the existing Conditions of Approval, and the requirements per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

2018 SCAG's 53rd General Assembly & Regional Conference: On May 2, 2018, the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) will host its annual General Assembly and Regional Conference in Indian Wells, CA. The theme of the three day conference is, "Southern California at a Crossroads" and will feature collaborative, solution-oriented discussions about the region's future with respect to transportation and housing. **RECREATION & PARKS**

Whale of a Day: The 2018 "Whale of a Day" celebration will be held this Saturday, April 14th, from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. The event is free to the public and is sponsored jointly by members of Los Serenos de Point Vicente and the City of Rancho Palos Verdes. The event will be held on the main grounds of the Point Vicente Interpretive Center at 31501 Palos Verdes Drive West. Free parking is available at the Rancho Palos Verdes City Hall with a free shuttle bus service to PVIC. Activities will include a beer and wine garden, food trucks, children's games, crafts, inflatables, face painting, puppet shows, tours of the Interpretive Center's museum, live music from local artists including the Smoky Hollow Blue Grass Band, two entertainment stages (one indoor, one outdoor), live dance performances, PV

Strings children's orchestra performance, and more than 50 marine-themed, local organizations and vendors. The Point Vicente Lighthouse will be open to the public for tours which are given on a first come, first served basis for ages 7 and older.
