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CITY MANAGER

Funeral for Gardena Motorcycle Officer at Green Hills on November 30th: The funeral service for Toshio Hirai, a 12-year veteran of the Gardena Police Department who died after sustaining injuries in a November 15th traffic collision, will be held at Green Hills Memorial Park on Friday, November 30th at 10:00 AM. The southbound No. 2 (i.e., curb) lane on Western Avenue will be closed for the funeral procession. Traffic control will be provided by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD). Surrounding residents and motorists should expect heavier-than-usual traffic on Western Avenue and a significant media presence before, during and after the service.

The City of Rancho Palos Verdes shares in the grief of Officer Hirai's family, friends and colleagues at the City of Gardena.

Status of Tax-Defaulted Property Purchases in Landslide Area: On November 7th, the City Council gave direction to Staff to proceed with acquiring two (2) adjoining tax-defaulted parcels in the active landslide area (APNs 7572-008-014 & 7572-008-016). On November 8th, Staff returned the executed Chapter 8 Agreement for APN 7572-008-014 to the County. On November 15th, Staff submitted an application to purchase APN 7572-008-016 to the County. The City's environmental consultant is preparing a Phase 1 Environmental Site Assessment for both parcels, and is expected to conduct a site visit to the properties on December 4th. The Planning Commission is tentatively scheduled to review these acquisitions for consistency with the City's General Plan in early 2019.

Possible Increase in Location Filming Activity due to Woolsey Fire: On November 20th, the Los Angeles Times reported on the impact that the recent wildfires has had upon location filming in California (see attachment). Almost as soon as the Woolsey fire began to expand toward Malibu, Staff began to receive calls and inquiries from productions whose locations were threatened, damaged or destroyed by the fire. The California Film Commission (CFC) issues film permits for the state lands in the Santa Monica Mountains and along the Malibu coastline. On November 13th, the CFC announced that it was canceling existing film permits in this area and would not accept new film permit applications until further notice. As such, Staff anticipates that we may see a "spike" in requests for location filming in Rancho Palos Verdes as productions seek to replace locations that were damaged or destroyed by the Woolsey fire.

Construction Update on Palos Verdes Peninsula Water Reliability Project: California Water Service (CalWater) continues to work on the installation of new pipelines within the public right-of-way of Palos Verdes Dr. N. and in equestrian trail easements in Rolling Hills Estates. Construction for the new pump station on Crenshaw Blvd. near Silver Spur Rd. is projected to begin by late November and to continue through the end of 2019. In the coming weeks, motorists and Rancho Palos Verdes residents living adjacent to the pump station site will start to see crews clearing the area around the location as part of preparatory work. FINANCE


Year over Year Sales Tax Receipts by Major Category (1st Quarter): Sales tax receipts for April through June 2018 were down 7.2% this same period last year. After adjusting for any reporting aberrations, actual sales tax receipts were down 1.6%.

The largest source of the reporting aberrations mentioned above were delayed remittances due to new reporting software at CDTFA (California Department of Tax and Fee Administration). Many agencies experienced a decline as many tax payers' second quarter returns were not processed in time to be included in the quarterly distribution. The City will continue to monitor the situation and record delayed cash receipts once they are received.

Fuel & Service Stations and State & Local County Pools saw the largest 2nd quarter year over year increase with 8.3% and 5.3% respective increases. Restaurants & Hotels made up the largest decrease in year over year sales tax revenue, dropping 5.4%.

PUBLIC WORKS

Residential Streets Rehabilitation Project, Area 8 (Miraleste Area Neighborhoods): This project consists of placing emulsion aggregate slurry seal on streets in public, residential neighborhoods adjacent to Palos Verdes Drive East (Via Subida and north) and adjacent to Miraleste Drive. Work this week included placing slurry seal. Door hanger notifications will be given to affected residents prior to any construction adjacent to their residence. Construction is typically scheduled through December 2018.



Coastal Bluff Fencing Phase II Project: This project consists of removing existing fences at Abalone Cove, Portuguese Point and Inspiration Point, and installing new concrete fences at these locations. Work is on schedule through December 2018.



Annual Sidewalk Repair Program FY17-18: This week, United GLI, will continue making improvements to sidewalks, driveway aprons, curbs and gutters at various locations on Shadow Wood Drive. Peninsula-Wide Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Plan: Staff met with Caltrans' Representatives last week to discuss the proposed project, implementation timeline, consultant procurement, reports, among other items. The following step is to procure a Consulting Firm with expertise and experience in the development of SRTS Plan. This program will benefit sixteen of the schools serving the Palos Verdes Peninsula (enrolling close to 11,400 students) and two of the Los Angeles Unified School District (2,350 students).

Deadman's Curve Segment (Conestoga Trail) Improvements: Staff is currently reviewing the pre-final design plans submitted by Penco Engineering Consulting Firm. Once the plans are finalized, the project will be advertised (tentatively) in early January 2019.

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PVIC Outdoor Lighting: The installation of outdoor lighting at PVIC is complete. The parking lot poles are well below the City's 10 feet height guideline. The bollards around the parking lots and trails, and the parking lot lights are solar-powered. Staff is in the process of preparing a punch list after the final walk through.



December and January IMAC Meetings: The December 17th IMAC meeting is cancelled. The January IMAC meeting will be rescheduled to Thursday January 10th at 6 pm in the Community Room. Notices of these meeting changes will be sent out.

Maintenance Activities: This past week, Public Works maintenance continued with its tree watering efforts along Hawthorne Blvd. and Crest Rd. Also, a parking permit signage was installed in the Del Cerro area to help alleviate parking overcrowding for the Del Cerro residents. Public Works also responded to and helped clean up a sewage spill located in front of Vanderlip Park on Sea Cove Dr. and L.A. County was notified to hydro jet the main line and get sewer services back online for residents in the area. Lastly, the Public Works crew cleaned up dry brush along Hawthorne Blvd. and Vallon Dr. that had accumulated, picked up trash and debris along the roadway on Miraleste Dr., and cleared out a fallen branch in the right of way on Indian Peak Rd.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Green Hills – Large Burial Service: On Friday, November 30th, between 10:00 a.m. and noon, burial services for fallen Gardena Police Officer Toshio Hiari will be held at Green Hills Memorial Park. The service is expected to be widely attended by fellow officers from several police departments and mourning community members. The service will take place at the center of the park (near Medal of Honor) with parking and shuttle service from Rolling Hills Covenant Church. The shuttle service will be provided through the gate along the shared property line between the Church and Green Hills, which should help mitigate traffic flow on Western Avenue. There will be limited live music and video monitors displaying photos of the fallen officer. Green Hills is working closely with the Gardena Police Department to minimize

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impacts to neighboring properties. Green Hills will be sending a courtesy notice to the abutting neighborhoods via their Mobile App and the City will be sending the same message to listserv subscribers and will email members of the Green Hills Neighborhood Advisory Committee.

Sol y Mar Update: The senior housing project on Crestridge Road is fast approaching completion. The last building obtained its final inspection in July 2018 and Staff is working with the Applicant to finalize miscellaneous inspections for the common areas of the site prior to issuing the final sign-off. In accordance to Condition No. 8 of Resolution No. 2013-031, an annual compliance review is required to occur at a noticed public hearing held one year after issuance of a final Certificate of Occupancy for the last building constructed. Since the final Certificate of Occupancy was issued on July 17, 2018, the annual compliance review will occur sometime around July 2019.

Rancho Palos Verdes' First Tesla Solar Roof:

Tesla Energy recently completed the installation of their first solar photovoltaic roofing system (solar roof) in southern California, and it is here in Rancho Palos Verdes on a residence located at 7422 Via Lorado. The solar roof system takes the functionality of solar panels and integrates it into roof shingles creating a visually appealing, electricity generating system. The system is paired with Tesla's Powerwall Battery, so that energy collected during the day can be stored and used any time. Drive by and see what this solar roof looks like!



November 14th LAX/ Community Noise Roundtable Meeting Follow-up: The Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) distributed Peninsula passenger jet overflight and altitude data for the months of September and October 2018 at its November 14th meeting (see attachment). At this meeting, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) staff returned as members of the Roundtable after an absence since November 2017. The FAA announced that there will be a local FAA Ombudsman to serve as a public liaison (staff to be determined). The Roundtable received a briefing on the Aircraft Noise Provisions included in the FAA Reauthorization Bill. The next Roundtable Meeting will be on Wednesday, January 9, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at LAX in the Clifton A. Moore Administration Building at 1 World Way.

Massive California fires disrupt TV and commercial production throughout the state

Netflix's teen drama series "13 Reasons Why" was in the midst of shooting its third season in Vallejo when the massive Camp fire and other blazes broke out in Northern California. The sets, which include a sound stage on Mare Island, weren't touched by the conflagrations, but the pervasive smoke that has shrouded much of the Bay Area has forced the show to temporarily halt shooting.

The Paramount-produced series is one of a number of TV and commercial shoots that have experienced disruptions because of the fires that have devastated California in recent weeks. Some prime shooting locations — including Paramount Ranch, which serves as a set for HBO's "Westworld," and the Peter Strauss Ranch in Agoura Hills — have experienced extensive damage, rendering them inaccessible to crews. Large swaths of Malibu that are popular filming sites are also closed to production.

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Location managers are used to natural disasters in California, but the scale of the recent fires and their effect on production throughout the state is unprecedented, according to industry veterans. The Woolsey fire in Malibu has destroyed more than 97,000 acres and killed three people, while the Camp fire in Butte County has consumed an estimated 151,000 acres and killed 77 (hundreds of others missing).

"I don't recall anything like this," said Amy Lemisch, executive director of the California Film Commission.

She said the commission, which oversees filming permits for state-owned lands, is currently unable to issue permits for such popular outdoor locations as Pacific Coast Highway, Will Rogers State Historic Park and numerous Malibu locales such as Malibu Creek State Park and Leo Carrillo State Park. Leo Carrillo has served as a location on numerous Hollywood films and TV series, including the 1960s sitcom "Gidget" and recent blockbusters such as Universal's "Furious 7."

The commission said it had to cancel about 30 filming permits for TV shows, commercials and other projects as a result of the fires.

Production insurance will typically cover costs that resulted from the cancellation of a film permit by the local government, said Peter Williams, global product lead at Allianz Entertainment, which provides film- and entertainment-related insurance products. In recent days, he said, "we have had claims for loss of permit or access to locations, particularly in the Malibu region."

Many productions were affected even before they filed their official permit applications.

The upcoming Netflix series "Dead to Me" was scouting locations around Malibu and Hidden Valley in Ventura County when the fires broke out.

"All five of the locations we scouted that afternoon [and] evening were under mandatory evacuation by the time we got back to the studio," said Debbie Page, a location manager on the CBS-produced series.

"Fortunately for us, we are going to be able to shoot in Hidden Valley at one of the chosen locations, but the director's favorite choice in Malibu seems like a pipe dream now."

Safety has become a top priority on sets near fire or smoke.

The producers of “13 Reasons Why” are expected to continue testing the air quality on the show’s sound stages and permanent sets around Vallejo before production resumes, said a person close to the production who wasn’t authorized to speak. The individual said that the hiatus is expected to last through the Thanksgiving break.

Los Angeles-area shoots frequently depend on L.A. Sheriff’s Department or California Highway Patrol personnel for security and other services. As a result of the fires, those resources have been stretched thin.

NBC’s “Timeless” saw its sheriff’s personnel pulled at the last minute last week, as did CBS’ “Navy Seals,” which was shooting near Compton, said David Stanley, who runs a production management services company.

Among the L.A.-area ranches that are popular shooting destinations, Paramount Ranch suffered the most serious damage as a result of the Woolsey fire. The ranch’s “western town” set that was featured in “Westworld” experienced near total destruction, said officials at the Santa Monica Mountains National Recreation Area.

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The plan is to rebuild the Paramount Ranch in the next two years, said superintendent David Szymanski.

At the time of the blaze, “Westworld” hadn’t begun production for its third season. The acclaimed series uses dozens of locations throughout Southern California, including Melody Ranch in Santa Clarita, which was not affected.

“It is too early to comment on any potential locations for Season 3, and it would be incorrect to infer that the production schedule and/or debut of Season 3 has been affected by the ongoing tragedy,” HBO said in a statement.

Paramount Ranch served as a location for the 2014 movie “American Sniper” as well as countless western films and TV series, such as CBS’ “Dr. Quinn, Medicine Woman.” The site dates to the silent era, when Paramount Pictures started leasing the land in 1923, eventually buying 2,700 acres four years later. Paramount later sold the ranch, and the property changed hands several times before the National Park Service acquired portions of the original land in 1980.

This isn’t the first time natural disasters have affected filming around the state. In 2016, the Sand fire damaged some of the movie ranches in Santa Clarita, including the Sable Ranch, which saw some of its western sets burn to the ground.

Last year’s catastrophic mudslide along Highway 1 in Big Sur also disrupted production in the area for months, according to the California Film Commission.

All five of the locations we scouted that afternoon [and] evening were under mandatory evacuation by the time we got back to the studio.

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Location managers who work in California are adept at dealing with a host of natural disasters. In film and TV production, location managers are in charge of finding and securing sets, and obtaining the necessary permits to film there.

They frequently work with location scouts, who are typically responsible for finding exteriors outside of traditional studio sets.

“Location managers and scouts are a fast-moving, resourceful and resilient bunch. We’re used to curveballs and we almost always have a few back up locations up our sleeve,” said JJ Levine, a vice president of the Location Managers Guild. “We consider ourselves as stewards of the community and quasi-historians in many ways, so of course we are deeply saddened by the loss of locations, which hold many memories for us.”

The recent fires come at a time when California is aggressively trying to bring back more TV and movie shoots through tax credits. The state gives \$330 million annually in credits to select productions and has persuaded several TV series such as HBO’s “Ballers” and Fox’s “Legion” to relocate production to the state.

Despite the extensive destruction, productions can still choose from rural lands that were unaffected by the fires.

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Among those is King Gillette Ranch in the Santa Monica Mountains near Malibu Creek State Park. The 588-acre ranch was undamaged by the Woolsey fire and is open for filming. NBC's reality competition series, "The Biggest Loser," has filmed extensively on the grounds.

"We were just fortunate enough that the fire didn't touch us," said Scott Hughes, a park ranger for the property. "This one piece of land was very lucky."



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

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





Sample Jet Departure Flight Track Over PV Peninsula
