**CITY MANAGER**

Utility Wildfire Mitigation Plans and Workshops: Senate Bill 901 requires electric utilities to prepare and submit wildfire mitigation plans that describe the utilities’ plans to prevent, combat, and respond to wildfires affecting their service territories. The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) opened a proceeding on October 25, 2018, to review the initial plans, and develop the process for review and implementation of wildfire mitigation plans.

On February 6, 2019, utilities submitted their wildfire mitigation plans to the CPUC. The CPUC will hold a series of workshops which started on February 13, 2019. For additional information visit <http://www.cpuc.ca.gov/sb901/>.

**PUBLIC WORKS**

Coastal Bluff Fence: About 230 feet of new fencing was installed and deteriorated fences were removed at the Vicente Bluff Reserve just north of PVIC on February 7th and 8th. More fencing is scheduled to be installed in the 2019-20 Fiscal Year.



Maintenance Activities: This week, Public Works Maintenance has continued to clean-up after the last storm and is preparing for the next storm. Public Works responded to downed trees and branches on Hawthorne Boulevard, Palos Verdes Drive South, Palos Verdes

Drive East and on Crest Road. Sandbags continue to be available to residents at City Hall. Electronic message boards are located on Palos Verdes Drive East reminding motorists to turn on their vehicles' headlights. Public Works cleared the San Ramon Canyon drainage grate of debris and vegetation, allowing for better rain flow. On Palos Verdes Drive West, Public Works filled in various potholes that formed during storms and actively repaired/replaced damaged street signs. New signage was added to the landslide area warning bicyclist of uneven road conditions. On Highridge Road, Public Works added the speed radar to help control speeding in that area. Finally, Public Works trimmed the trees at the City Hall entrance and restored the view of Catalina Island to City Hall visitors.

### **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

City of Rancho Palos Verdes Receives National SolSmart Gold Designation: On February 11, 2019, the City was informed that it is the recipient of a Gold designation from the national SolSmart program for making it faster, easier and more affordable for homes and businesses in the community to go solar. The SolSmart program is led by the Solar Foundation and the International City/County Management Association and funded by the U.S. Department of Energy. The SolSmart Gold designation is a signal that the City is "open for solar business" and through the partnership with the SBCCOG and EcoMotion, the City will receive additional technical assistance to further more energy efficiency goals in the City. The City also received special recognition in the 'Inspections' category for its efforts in furthering solar-readiness.



### Natural Communities Conservation Plan / Habitat Conservation Plan (NCCP/HCP) Update:

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service), in collaboration with the City, will be recirculating the Draft Environmental Assessment, the Draft NCCP/HCP and associated documents for an additional 30-day public comment period (the original public comment period concluded on December 31, 2018). This additional public comment period will begin within the coming week based on the publishing date of the Federal Register (additional notification will be given when published).

The Service is extending the public comment period, in part, due to the recent government shutdown and to maximize public review. The Draft NCCP/HCP provided on the City's website during the previous 60-day public comment period was the version of the document considered by City Council at the March 29, 2018 City Council Meeting,

however, it did not include changes accepted by City Council, via late correspondence, at the City Council Meeting, nor did it include technical edits to the draft made after the March 29th City Council Meeting. Thus, the City will be providing two versions of the documents for the 30-day public review: a clean copy of the documents (includes all changes) and a tracked changes document. Notification will be given to the public announcing the availability of the documents.

Trails Network Plan Update: On, January 15, 2019, the City Council approved a Professional Service Agreement with the consultant, Alta Planning and Design, to assist the City in updating the Trails Network Plan. A kick-off meeting will be held between Staff and the Consultant within the next week to identify the next steps before conducting the first public workshop.

Special Use Permit (SUP) for a Soil Vapor Extraction System (SVE) at Golden Cove: Staff previously reported that on January 31, 2019, the Director of Community Development issued a Notice of Decision allowing a 1-year time extension to the temporary operation of an SVE system at the Golden Cove Shopping Center. The appeal period ended on February 6, 2019 and no appeals were filed with the City. The operation of the SVE system restarted on February 7, 2019 and will continue operating for one-year subject to the Conditions of Approval, which, among other things, limit the hours of operation and require additional sound attenuation.

## **RECREATION & PARKS**

Hesse Park: The facilities are rented this week for twelve indoor recreation classes, four non-profit group rentals, one private rentals, three Peninsula Seniors activities and one Little Critters activity located in McTaggart Hall on Wednesday February 12th, 2019.

Ladera Linda Park: The facilities are rented this week for four recreation classes and one non-profit rental.

Ryan Park: The facilities are being used this week for five indoor recreation classes and two private rentals.

PVIC/Docents: The new docent class met in the Sunset Room Wednesday afternoon and gave their individual presentations on their research topics. Alisa Schulman Janiger with the American Cetacean Society will be giving a presentation Wednesday evening in the sunset room to the docents. The room is rented Friday for a private event.
