FINANCE

PUBLIC WORKS

Abalone Cove and Ryan Park Air Conditioning Improvements: Air conditioning units have been installed at both locations with the addition of insulation at the parking kiosk at Abalone Cove. This project provides a more comfortable environment for parks staff during the hot weather months.



Maintenance Activities: This week Public Works maintenance continues its brush clearance. Locations, where the brush has been cleared, include Sunnyside Ridge, Switchbacks, and Shoreline Boarder. Public Works re-cleared City Hall and Via Capri property. Palos Verdes South near Abalone Cove was cleared of center median weeds as well. In parks, scheduled maintenance is on track. Irrigation repairs were made at the following locations: East View Park, Monte Malaga Drive, Ganado, Hesse Park, and PVIC. Tree median maintenance also continues to take place on Monte Malaga Drive.

In the Del Cerro Neighborhood, the Park Place entrance signage was updated to reflect new parking permit rules as you enter the park per parking enforcement agent. In addition, on Monte Malaga, the wall that was falling and collapsing is being repaired. Public Works has closed sidewalk and bike lanes while work is proceeding.

Emergency response this week includes a large tree that fell over on Via Canada over the weekend. Fire Department was on scene and cut up the tree. Public Works also responded and did clean up and hauling of materials. Public Works is also inspecting trees in the area for safety.

Lastly, Public Works is working with the Parks Department to set up the Annual 4th of July City celebration. In conjunction with the City Hall celebration, Public Works has been asked to help with the East View Park 4th of July celebration set up as well.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Assembly Bill 68 – Accessory Dwelling Units: It has been a very active year on housing policy and land use with the most significant development being the tabling of SB 50 (Wiener) and AB 1279 (Bloom) for the rest of this year. Staff is currently monitoring AB 68 (Ting) which is moving through the process that would authorize a local agency, by ordinance, the ministerial approval of accessory dwelling units in single-family and multi-family residential zones without imposing lot coverage and minimum lot size requirements. Furthermore, AB 68 would allow, among other things, accessory dwelling units up to 16' in height with 4' side and rear yard setbacks, and would require the local agency to render a decision within 60 days after receiving a complete application. Earlier this week, Senator Ben Allen's office contacted Staff who expressed its concerns to AB 68 because it further erodes local control.

City-owned Decibel Noise Meter: Staff recently purchased a decibel noise meter in response to the City Council enacting Code language that finds mechanical equipment generating noise levels in excess of 65 dBA at the closest property line a public nuisance. The noise meter is certified and calibrated with test results showcasing the accuracy of +/- .5db, and the Code Enforcement Officers have been trained to operate the noise meter. The City was able to purchase the noise meter for approximately \$300, saving roughly \$500 from the estimated cost reported to the City Council in May 2019.

Los Angeles County Department of Animal Care and Control - General Meeting: On June 25, 2019, the Code Enforcement Officers attended a meeting conducted by the L.A. County Department of Animal Care and Control (DACC) to discuss their operational effectiveness.

The meeting was held at the Hall of Administration office in Downtown L.A. and was attended by approximately 47 cities who contract with the County for animal control services. The DACC is currently assessing the services it provides, evaluating alternative service models, leveraging technology where feasible, and identifying areas where operating costs can be reduced. As part of meeting, feedback was gathered from participants that generally focused on customer service and billing. The Code Enforcement Officers used this opportunity to express its concerns regarding the County's procedures related to barking dog complaints and the effectiveness of the recently amended procedures.

Mira Catalina Elementary School Brush Clearance: On June 17, 2019, a resident in the Mira Catalina neighborhood filed a coyote sighting activity on the City's web app that involved a coyote entering a yard with pets. In response, on June 20, 2019, the Code Enforcement Officers along with L.A. County Weights and Measures Officers conducted a site assessment that included Mira Catalina Elementary School. During the site assessment, Staff observed substantial dead and unmaintained foliage along the school's open space hillside abutting residents on Deluna Drive that may provide shelter for coyote dens. Soon after, the Code Enforcement Officers contacted school administration and was able to coordinate foliage clearance scheduled to occur in the coming weeks.

RECREATION & PARKS

Ladera Linda Park: LL hosted Flutterby story time for children and adults last Tuesday. Rentals for this week included two recreation classes and one non-profit rental.

Ryan Park: The facility is being used this week for one indoor recreation classes, one Scout class, a week of camp and one softball practice.

PVIC/Docents: The Sunset room is rented Friday for a private event. The room and outdoor amphitheater is rented Saturday for a private event. The PVIC Gift shop staff will be conducting Inventory the evening of June 30th.

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The Grant Administrator from the California Natural Resource Agency came to PVIC last Thursday to conduct the site close out visit for the PVIC Exhibit Replacement Project. The new Fresnel lens and Whaling exhibit was partially funded through a grant from the CNRA. The representative was thoroughly impressed and commented that the exhibits were even better in person than in the pre-closeout photos.



Little Fish Tales by the Sea monthly enrichment program met on June 20th. The attendance doubled from last month, 60 children and their parents attended. We had some new families attend as well as regular attendees. Kids enjoyed books, songs, felt board activities and movement. Coloring pages were also offered. We offered a blowing bubbles activity on the patio to go along with the "bubble" theme of the books and activities. Next month marks the City's sixth year of partnership with the Palos Verdes Library district in bringing this program to the Point Vicente Interpretive Center.



REACH: On Monday, REACH members learned how to make pizza and enjoyed an evening of art. On Wednesday, REACH went to Subway for dinner and played bocce in San Pedro.

Healthy RPV: Open Gym: Twenty people attended open gym at Miraleste Intermediate last Wednesday. There was no open gym last Sunday.




