Named after three ridges that traverse the parcel, walk through a 21-acre habitat restoration area that is home to rare birds like the cactus wren. Strenuous. RPV

february 13, 9 am deane dana friendship park

Enjoy some of the best LA/Long Beach harbor and Catalina views on the east side of the Peninsula. See PV blue butterfly habitat restoration area. Moderate. LA

march 12, 9 am linden h. chandler preserve

Experience this impressively restored 28-acre nature preserve, offering a new home for the rare Palos Verdes blue butterfly. Learn about the fascinating geology of the area. Moderate. RHE

april 9, 9 am forrestal reserve

View dramatic geological formations and spectacular wildflower blooms following El Niño's rains. Moderate to strenuous. RPV

may 14, 3 pm white point nature preserve

View a premier example of the Conservancy's restoration of coastal sage scrub habitat and listen for the gnatcatcher as you walk. Stop at a former gun emplacement to learn military history of the area. A Nature Education Center has activities for the whole family. Moderate. LA

june 11, 9 am abalone cove shoreline park

Visit the newly landscaped trails lined with drought tolerant plants and interpretive signage. Enjoy a walk down to explore the tide pools and pillow lava formations. Moderate. RPV

july 9, 9 am la rotunda/ocean trails - west reserve

Walk along restored habitat on the bluffs surrounding the Trump National Golf Club and possibly catch a glimpse of rare California gnatcatcher songbirds while walking to the beach. Moderate to strenuous. RPV

august 13, 9 am vicente bluffs/ vanderlip park

Traverse the cliff side trail along Terranea's grounds to Vanderlip Park. Explore habitat that is home to the rare El Segundo blue butterfly with beautiful views of Catalina Island. Strenuous. 2-1/2 hours. RPV

september 10, 9 am alta vicente reserve

Follow North Spur Trail to visit a beautiful restoration area for native cactus wren and California gnatcatcher and listen for their distinct calls. Visit the new recognition site for Golden Poppy Heritage Circle Members. Strenuous. RPV

october 8, 9 am lower portuguese bend reserve

Follow Sandbox Trail ascending through grasses and low shrubs for nice views of the Pacific Ocean. Easy. RPV

november 12, 2 pm portuguese bend reserve

Walk through an area of beautiful coastal sage scrub habitat regrown after 2009 fire and refreshed by the rainy season. Moderate to strenuous. RPV

december 10, 9 am filiorium reserve new walk!

Walk Jack's Hat Trail on this 191-acre property preserved in 2009 linking the Three Sisters and Portuguese Bend Reserves. This wildlife corridor boasts beautiful ocean views and native habitat. Strenuous. RPV

january 14, 2017, 9 am vicente bluffs reserve

Follow the bluff top from Point Vicente to Oceanfront Estates, an area containing high quality coastal bluff scrub habitat. Great location for sighting whales. Easy. RPV



January 9, 9 am Three Sisters Reserve – Park free in lot at St. Peter's by the Sea Church, 6410 Palos Verdes Dr. South, RPV

February 13, 9 am Deane Dana Friendship Park – Park in the Nature Center parking lot, 1805 W. 9th Street, San Pedro, LA

March 12, 9 am Linden H. Chandler Preserve – From Rolling Hills Road turn onto Empty Saddle Road and park in the lot at Empty Saddle Club, 39 Empty Saddle Rd, RHE

April 9, 9 am Forrestral Reserve – Park along Forrestral Dr. or park in lot at Ladera Linda Community Center. Meet near gate. 32201 Forrestral Drive, RPV

May 14, 3 pm White Point Nature Preserve – At southern end of Western Ave turn left onto Paseo del Mar and drive 1/2 mile, enter gate on left and park in lot, LA

August 13, 9 am Vicente Bluffs/Vanderlip Park – Park at Pelican Cove lot, 1300 Palos Verdes Drive South, RPV


September 10, 9 am Alta Vicente Reserve – Park at RPV City Hall, 30940 Hawthorne Blvd, RPV
