





REACH - Therapeutic Recreation Program

What is REACH?

REACH is a community outreach program administered by the City of Rancho Palos Verdes Recreation and Parks Department. Our program is designed to serve the social and recreational needs of adults with developmental disabilities in Rancho Palos Verdes and the South Bay on a space available basis. REACH offers recreational programs throughout the year that are diverse and challenging, while promoting social interaction, physical fitness, independent living and community assimilation.

What types of programs does REACH offer?

Evening programs at Hesse Park provide an opportunity for participants to prepare and eat dinner together. The evening is topped off with arts and crafts, games, or a physical activity. Off-site activities consist of outings to local restaurants and various fun activities such as bowling, miniature golf, movies, and local musical performances. Weekend events vary, such as adventures to theme parks, museums, gardens, and cultural events.
