

NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public meeting on **Tuesday, September 2, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. at Hesse Park Community Building located at 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard** to consider the adoption of the Vision Plan for the Rancho Palos Verdes Coast. The purpose of the Vision Plan is to create a coordinated master plan for key sites along the City's coastline, with public access, interpretive materials, recreational amenities, and other facilities to improve the experience of the coast and open space for residents of and visitors to the Peninsula. The Vision Plan identifies program, design and linkage concepts for the entire area. The five key sites (see map below) identified in the Vision Plan are: Upper Point Vicente, Lower Point Vicente, Abalone Cove, Gateway Park, and Del Cerro Park (the sites identified in the Vision Plan are outside, but adjacent to, the Palos Verdes Nature Preserve). The Vision Plan under consideration by the City Council is a result of numerous public workshops since the June 2006. The Vision Plan can be viewed on the City's website at www.palosverdes.com/rpv under the Current Topics and Projects page for the Vision Plan or at the Planning Department at the Rancho Palos Verdes City Hall, at Ladera Linda, at Hesse Park, or the Palos Verdes Peninsula Main Library.



All interested parties are invited to submit written comments and to attend and give testimony at the September 2nd Council Meeting. If you wish to submit written comments, please provide them to the Director of Planning, Building, and Code Enforcement by noon on Tuesday, September 2, 2008. Written comments submitted by Monday, August 25, 2008 will be included in the City Council Staff Report. The City Council Staff Report on the Vision Plan will be available after Wednesday, August 27, 2008 on the City's website at www.palosverdes.com/rpv, under the September 2, 2008 City Council Agenda.
