

# Open Space, Recreation and Parks Task Force


- Task Force formed May 2002-Update Parks Master Plan

  - Maintenance and Improvement
  - Open Space/CTP
  - Land Acquisition
  - Equestrian
  - Senior Citizens Center/Cultural Development
  - Upper Point Vicente

# July 2003 Public Survey

- Majority of residents wanted Parkland left in natural state
- Upper Point Vicente survey results:
  - 80% Trail heads to natural space
  - 69% Village green w/gardens, walkways
  - 64% Outdoor swimming pool
  - 59% Sport gym
  - 59% Outdoor playing fields
  - 57% Renovate City Hall, 47% New City Hall
