

NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Rancho Palos Verdes on Tuesday, November 5, 2019, for the following Officers and Measure:

For three (3) Members of the City Council; for a full term of three (3) years; term expiring November 2022*

Shall the measure, known as the HOSPITALITY WORKING CONDITIONS ORDINANCE , placed on the ballot by initiative petition, applicable to large hotels, golf courses and amusement parks, and which enacts a wage floor of \$15/hour (CPI adjustments), limits daily work hours, limits daily square footage of rooms cleaned, requires panic-buttons for employees, requires maintenance of detailed compliance records, prohibits employer retaliation against employees, requires employee notices, and imposes fines and attorneys' fees for violation, be adopted? The nomination period for these offices begins on Monday, July 15, 2019, and closes Friday, August 9, 2019, at 4:30 p.m.


If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the city are not filed by 4:30 p.m. on August 9, 2019, the nomination period shall be extended until August 14, 2019, at 5:00 P.M., for persons other than the incumbent. This extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by § 10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

On Election Day, the polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

**Pursuant to City of Rancho Palos Verdes Ordinance No. 591, elections for the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will be changed from November in odd-numbered years to November in even-numbered years beginning in year 2020 to coincide with statewide election dates. As a result in the change in election date, the City Council Member terms of office that begin in 2019 will expire in November 2022, causing a three-year term instead of the traditional four-year term.*
