




Eastview Park

□ History

- **Site owned by Los Angeles County Sanitation District**
- **Leased by the City of Rancho Palos Verdes since 1990**
- **Officially dedicated on November 18, 1990**
- **Lease has 60-day opt out clause if land was needed for Sanitation District Use**
- **City may be required to remove any improvements at the discretion of the District if the land is taken back.**


Eastview Park

□ History

- Eastview considered as a possible site for youth soccer, football, lacrosse or girls softball location in 2005.
- Determined that significant grading would be required and the permission of the Sanitation District would have to be obtained.
- Improvement to existing fields at Hesse Park and Ryan Park completed in 2011.

□ Background/details




- **9.9 Acres**
- **Only City park on the border between RPV and San Pedro**
- **Park Improvements completed in 1990 at a cost of \$417,000**
- **New playground equipment installed in 2012**
- **30 Year Lease with Sanitation District expiring in 2019**

Temporary Dog Park

- **Similar to Rancho Caninos Dog Park located at Pt. Vicente Park.Civic Center (City Hall Location)**
- **\$50,000 in current FY 14-15 budget to fund this project**

Rancho Caninos Dog Park Details

- Half-acre in size
- Small dog and large dog areas
- Temporary facility
- Shaded area
- Water faucets and bowls for dogs
- Restroom and hand wash station
- ADA Accessible
- Dogs leashed when outside of the facility



Eastview Park

□ Summary of Feedback from 11-5-14 Workshop

- **Generally Pro-Dog Park (preferred location nearer to Western Avenue)**
- **Concerns about dogs off leash**
- **Requests to widen and level the walking path**
- **Generally positive reaction to fitness station (preferred having them located along walking path)**
- **Concerns expressed about maintenance, graffiti, and vandalism- notably dying vegetation in NE corner of park, trash in parking lot area**
- **Request to put benches under trees for shade**
- **Generally positive response to shade structure**
- **Strong desire to keep the park's low-key neighborhood feel**

□ Additional 11-5-14 Workshop Feedback

- **Generally positive response to shade structure**
- **Strong desire to keep the park's low-key neighborhood feel**
- **No Skate Park**
- **More Mutt Mitt dispensers and improved signage**
- **Concerns raised about feral cats**
- **Unanimous no to BBQs and Moon Bounces**


□ Additional Feedback

- **Fence around Playground (email suggestion)**
- **Disc golf (survey response)**
- **More programs for residents on East Side (survey response)**
- **Homeless concerns at Eastview (survey response)**

- **More recreation programs on East side (survey)**
- **Playground equipment hard for kids to use (survey)**
- **Remove trees that drop “spiked” seeds—hurts dogs’ paws (survey)**


□ Relevant Survey Results

- 341 respondents as of 1-13-15
- 25% of respondents report using a dog park on a monthly basis
- 90% hike, walk or jog
- 40% picnic or relax at a local park
- 19% attend an RPV special event
