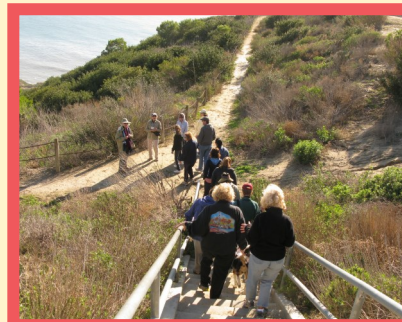
### **LAND CONSERVANCY PUBLIC HIKE**
