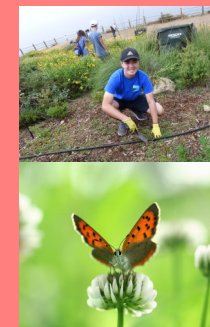
2ND ANNUAL KIDS TO PARKS DAY
