

ATTESTATION OF COMMUNITY CONSENSUS

To demonstrate community consensus, neighbors may write or sign their name. If the project is within 50 feet of private property, the property owner (Adjacent Property Owner) should be notified of the proposed project. The neighborhood should use its discretion in the numbers of signatures it should collect to demonstrate consensus and support for the project. Applicant should consider receiving signatures from 40% of homeowners within the neighborhood. Utilize additional pages as needed.
