Portuguese Bend Landslide Local Emergency Update

Palos Verdes Drive South Repair Discussion, July 16

On July 16, the City Council will consider planned repairs to the steep section of Palos Verdes Drive South between Narcissa and Peppertree Drives, also known as the “ski jump.” The stretch spans two sub-slides in the Portuguese Bend Landslide complex that are pulling away from each other, causing cracks that have made the roadway more difficult to traverse and in need of frequent repairs.

At the direction of the Council, City staff has explored the possibility of completely regrading the ski jump using innovative materials such as geofoam blocks, which are synthetic lightweight blocks with similar compression strength as traditional fill materials. Staff has determined this work would likely exceed \$5 million, necessitate roadway closures for several weeks, and require significant maintenance due to the risk of the ski jump continuing to pull apart. Therefore, this option is not recommended at this time.

At Tuesday's meeting, the Council will consider the recommended option to continue asphalt repairs on a regular basis, while awaiting the City's landslide mitigation measures to significantly slow the landslide movement. Regular repaving of the ski jump section of Palos Verdes Drive South is estimated to cost \$750,000 to \$1 million over the course of a year.

**SBA Financial Assistance Applications for Property Damage Due July 16**

Reminder: The deadline for California businesses and residents to apply for a low-interest loan from the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) for property damage caused by recent severe winter storms is July 16.

- Disaster loans up to \$500,000 are available to homeowners to repair or replace damaged or destroyed real estate.

- Homeowners and renters are eligible for up to \$100,000 to repair or replace damaged or destroyed personal property, including personal vehicles.
- Businesses of all sizes and private nonprofit organizations may borrow up to \$2 million to repair or replace damaged or destroyed real estate, machinery and equipment, inventory and other business assets.
- SBA can also lend additional funds to businesses and homeowners to help with the cost of improvements to protect, prevent or minimize damage from occurring in the future.

A Virtual Disaster Loan Outreach Center is available with SBA customer service representatives who can answer questions about SBA's disaster loan program, explain the application process, and help complete applications. No appointment is necessary.



Portuguese Bend Landslide Remediation Emergency Hydraugers Project Update

On May 21, 2024, the City Council approved the Portuguese Bend Landslide Remediation Emergency Hydraugers Project, which consists of the installation of two hydraugers with five drain arrays each. The hydraugers will be used to extract and/or intercept groundwater from the landslide area as an emergency stabilization measure to reduce movement in the Portuguese Bend Landslide. Following are the most recent activities:

- Drilling of the first four vertical boreholes is complete. Drilling of the fifth vertical borehole has started and is anticipated to be completed by early next week.
- Site preparation ahead of successive vertical borehole drilling continues within the Portuguese Bend Reserve. Site preparation for the four boreholes west of the Portuguese Bend Beach Club neighborhood is anticipated to start within the next two weeks.
- Instrumentation to gauge land movement continues to be installed in each borehole.
- Environmental monitoring is being conducted in conjunction with construction activities.
- A total of 20 boreholes are anticipated to be installed over the course of the next several weeks.

Minor traffic delays are to be expected over the course of the next several weeks as construction materials and equipment deliveries continue to arrive at the Gateway






Update for Remodeling Project at 29105-29229 S. Western Avenue Shopping Center (Western Plaza)

On July 5, 2024, the Building & Safety Division of the Community Development Department approved a Major Grading Permit (Permit No. PLGR2024-0005) for the existing shopping center known as "Western Plaza", at the south-west corner of Western Avenue and Trudie Drive located at 29105-29229 S. Western Avenue. The project proposes to recontour an existing parking lot for improved drainage, the construction of new landscape areas throughout the remodeled and restriped parking lot, and ancillary structures including the replacement of four existing light poles with 33 new light poles in the parking lot. The Applicant will soon be working with the City's Building & Safety Division on grading plan check and permitting. Landslide Complex Interim Housing Solutions

Pursuant to City Council direction on July 2, 2024, City staff is exploring options for interim housing solutions within the Portuguese Bend Landslide Complex. The item is scheduled to be before City Council on August 20, 2024. Staff is working collaboratively with the community to preserve existing structures within the landslide complex and consider

Code Enforcement Staff

The Community Development Department's Code Enforcement Division is fully staffed with two full-time Officers, Victoria Powers and James Zoren. Officer Zoren is a Certified Code Enforcement (CCE) Officer through the California Association of Code Enforcement Officers (CACEO). He has a B.A. in Sociology and an A.A. in Criminal Justice with extensive code enforcement experience in diverse communities in both rural and urban cities.



Officer Powers has a Master's degree in Emergency Services Administration and comes from a background in public safety and emergency services education. Officer Powers is presently pursuing certification from the CACEO.

The Code Enforcement team has a combined total of over 15 years of public service experience. Code enforcement investigates RPV municipal code violations occurring on private property. Officers work in close association with the Public Works Department, Planning, Building and Safety Divisions, and the Lomita Sheriff's Office to maintain high community standards. Abalone Cove Reserve

On July 9, Abalone Cove Trail, Beach School Trail and Chapel View Trail were temporarily closed until further notice due to impacts from the landslide. Signage has been placed at corresponding trailheads to inform the public. More information is available on page 7 of this report.

Alta Vicente Reserve

On July 5, Staff trimmed back several palm fronds overgrowing onto North Spur Trail. Staff also inspected and disposed of several items found along Nike Trail. The trail continues to be temporarily closed while crews are on site between 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. through Friday, July 5 due to a non-native vegetation removal project conducted by the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy.



On July 8, staff continued to trim an overgrowth of native plants along Rattlesnake Trail.



On July 8, Staff inspected and performed several spur trail closures along Rattlesnake Trail. Spur trails are unauthorized trails that are not permitted and may cause trampling of native habitat and sensitive areas. The City will continue to work with several partners, including the habitat manager and the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy to make improvements along the trail.




Ocean Trails Reserve

Portuguese Bend Reserve
