## What Will You Do If You Must Evacuate During an Emergency?

We cannot prevent all disasters, but we can prepare! Having a plan is critical when you need to act quickly to protect yourself and your loved ones. If you receive an Evacuation Order and must leave the area immediately, will you be ready to go? Answer the questions below to help you make your plan and be prepared.



**How will you be notified?** Get information about evacuation routes and resources by signing up for Alert South Bay at <https://alertsouthbay.com/> or text “alertrpv” to 888-777.



**Where can you go?** Identify at least 2 places outside of your area that you can stay at if you must evacuate. Make sure you have plans for your animals too!



**How will you get there?** Have a backup plan if you are unable to use your regular transportation and keep gas tanks at least halfway full. *Gas stations may be closed during a disaster!*



**What do you need to take with you?** Consider what you will need while evacuated and make a kit (ex. water/food, cash, medicine, clothes, sturdy shoes, important documents, etc.).





**What else will you need?** Consider comfort and entertainment items for children, supplies for animals, and back up pharmacies and medical services (ex. dialysis) in locations you may evacuate to.

Practice your plan at least twice a year with everyone in your household, including animals and children. This can help make evacuations easier and less stressful.

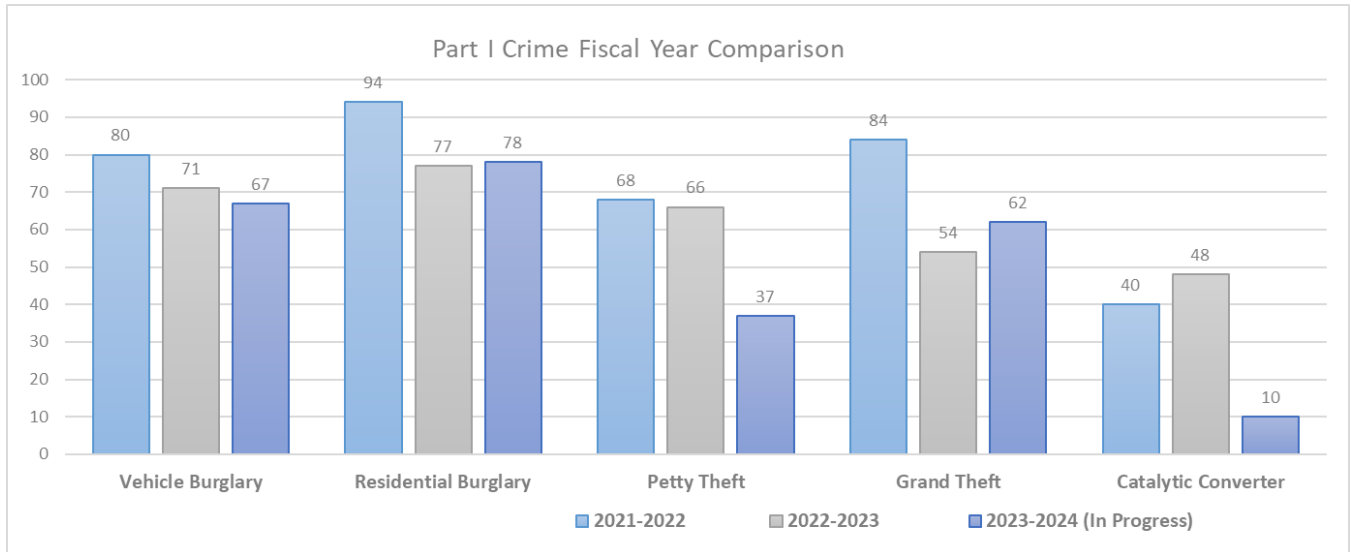

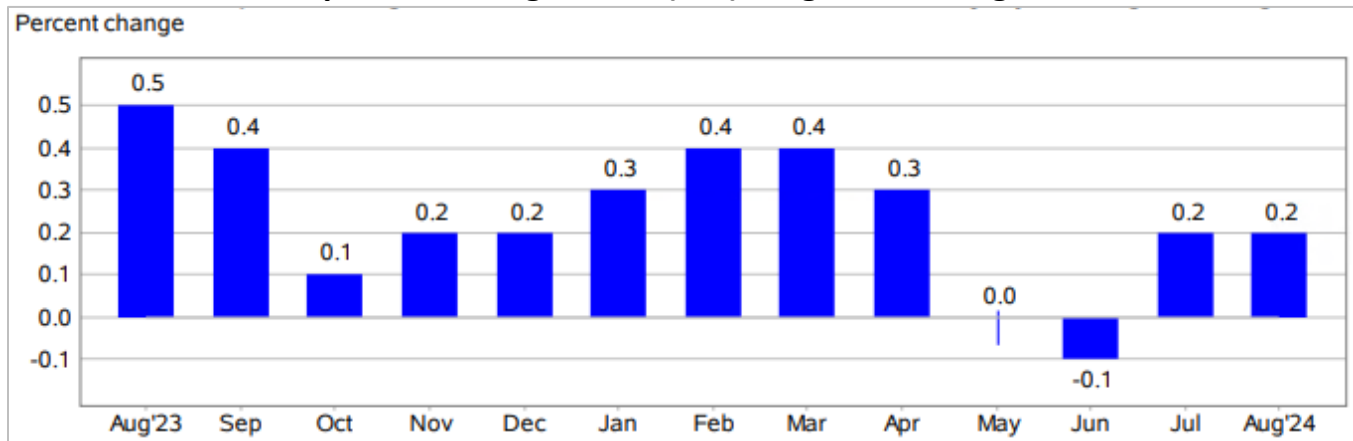

### Consumer Price Index – August 2024

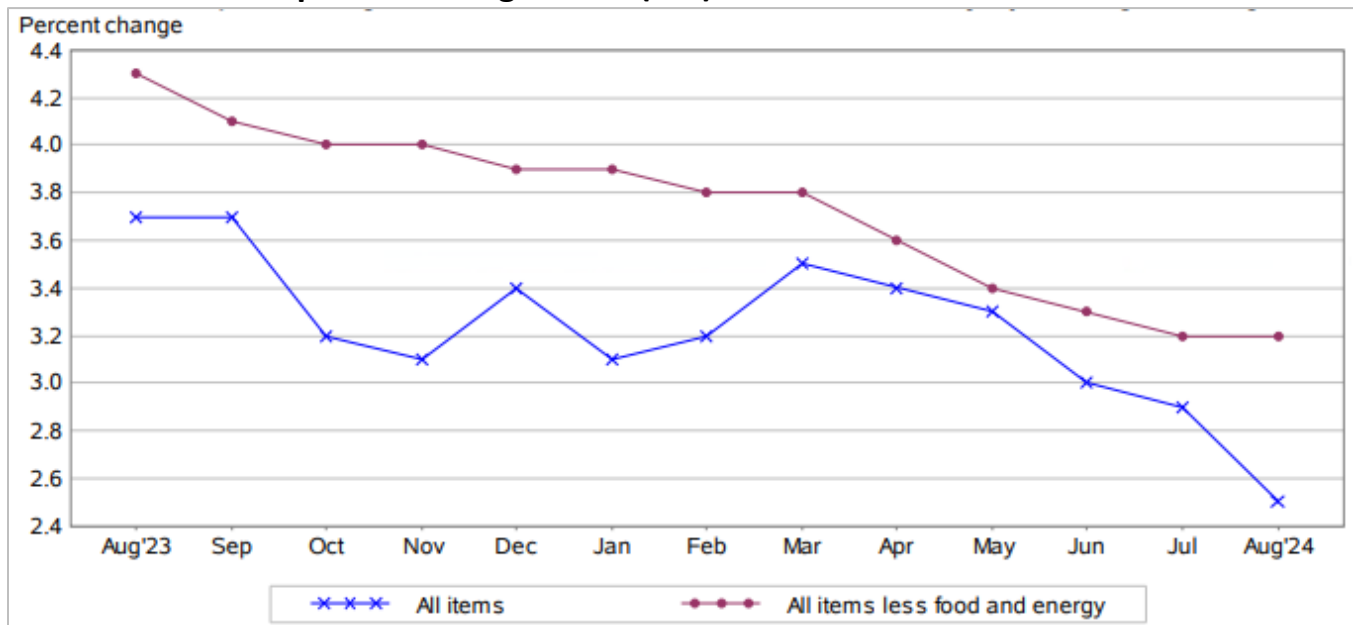
In August, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased by 0.2% over the month, the same increase as in July. The index for shelter rose by 0.5% in August and was the main factor in the latest increase. Energy prices fell by 0.8% after being unchanged in July. Over the past year, the all items index, or CPI, rose by 2.5% and continued its downward trend.

Moreover, the food index increased by 2.1% while the energy index decreased by 4.0% for the 12 months ending August. Excluding food and energy (core CPI), the index rose by 0.3% from July to August and rose by 3.2% over the last year.

**Chart 1. One-month percent change in CPI (U.S), Aug. 2023 – Aug. 2024**



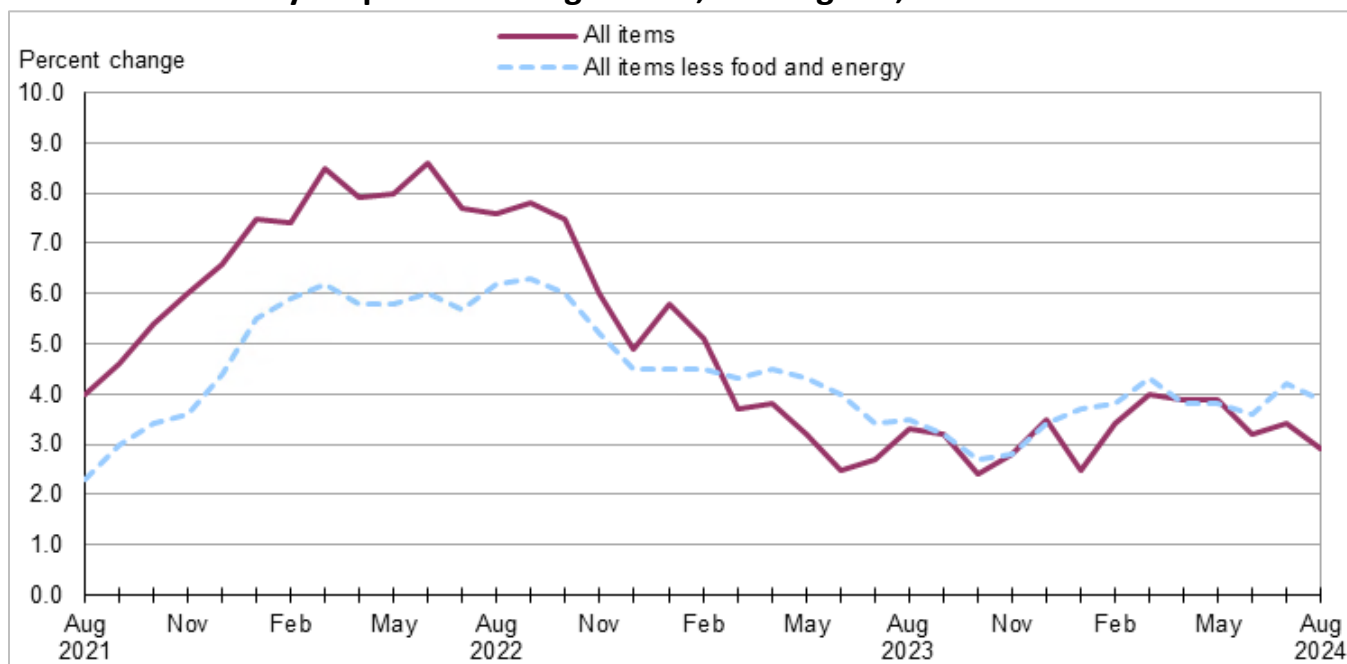
**Chart 2. 12-month percent change in CPI (U.S)**



## Consumer Price Index – Los Angeles Area

As measured by the CPI, prices in the Los Angeles area increased by 0.1% in August. The monthly increase was once again influenced by higher prices for shelter. Over the past 12 months, CPI grew by 2.9% after rising by 3.4% through July. Measured annually, food prices are up 2.5%, while energy prices fell by 8.8% largely due to the lower prices for gasoline. The index for all items less food and energy increased 3.9% over the year.

## PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT



### **Portuguese Bend Landslide Remediation Emergency Hydraugers Project Update**

On May 21, 2024, the City Council approved the Portuguese Bend Landslide Remediation Emergency Hydraugers Project, which consists of the installation of two hydraugers with five drain arrays each. The hydraugers were preceded by test boreholes to better understand underground conditions. Those boreholes revealed a deeper slide plane that is moving at a much faster rate than the shallow slide plane.

The unprecedented rate of movement of the deeper slip plane is resulting in a change in the landslide remediation strategy to prioritize the deeper slip plane. Test boreholes will continue in the landslide area to complete the picture of underground conditions throughout the landslide.

Meanwhile, vertical dewatering wells that will penetrate the deeper slide plane to relieve water pressure are being designed and constructed as quickly as possible. Installation of the first vertical deep dewatering well has started and the second well is being scheduled within the next week.

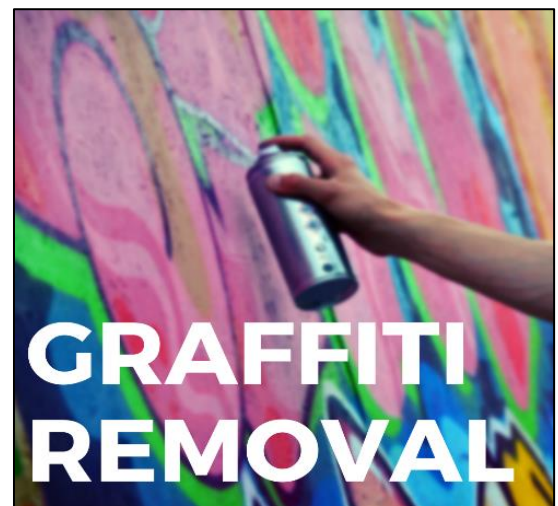


- Replaced a wooden railing at Palos Verdes Drive East.

On September 3, 2024, the City Council adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 687U, which established regulations and procedures to install temporary measures to preserve existing structures and to authorize temporary housing on properties within the Portuguese Bend Landslide Complex. The ordinance authorizes the temporary use of such improvements until December 31, 2026, unless extended by the City Council. Permits are required for the installation of the temporary improvements. ### **Update for Remodeling Project at 29105-29229 S. Western Avenue Shopping Center (Western Plaza)**

On September 4, 2024, the City's Building & Safety Division accepted a tenant improvement application to establish a new Urbane Café at the shopping center located at 29105-29229 S. Western Avenue, formerly known as the "Western Plaza." Urbane Café is a quick serve sandwich and salad shop

with various locations throughout California. Earlier this year, the Building & Safety Division issued permits for a comprehensive remodel of the shopping center, which is located at the south-west corner of Western Avenue and Trudie Drive. Staff expects to receive additional tenant improvement plans for the other spaces in the coming weeks

## Whole Foods Volunteers Make a Difference at Ryan Park

Recreation and Parks employee Seth Masters inspired a volunteer group. His mother who works at Whole Foods put together a volunteer group to work on the native plant garden at Ryan Park. On September 8, 5 volunteers worked cooperatively to remove weeds from the planter and overgrowth from under the pepper tree. Native plants including deerweed were purchased from the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy. The volunteers laid out the plants





near sprinkler heads to assure they received adequate water and dug holes to plant them. After four hours of hard work, the plants were happily routed in their new home. While working, to accentuate the presentation of each plant, 2 monarch butterfly caterpillars were found munching on narrow leaf milkweed under the pepper tree. The milkweed was planted by a Boy Scout Troop 4 years ago.



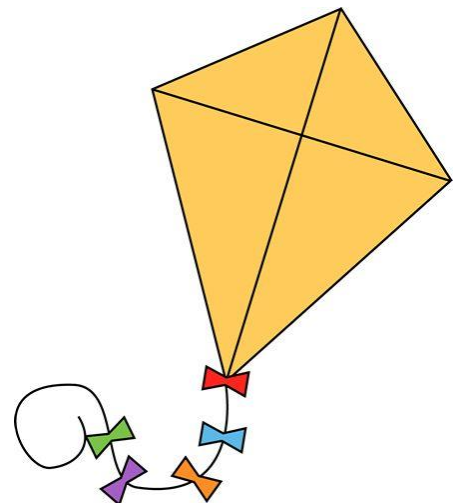
## REACH Update

The REACH program serves the social and recreational needs of youths and adults with developmental disabilities and is back at Hesse Park for in-person activities.

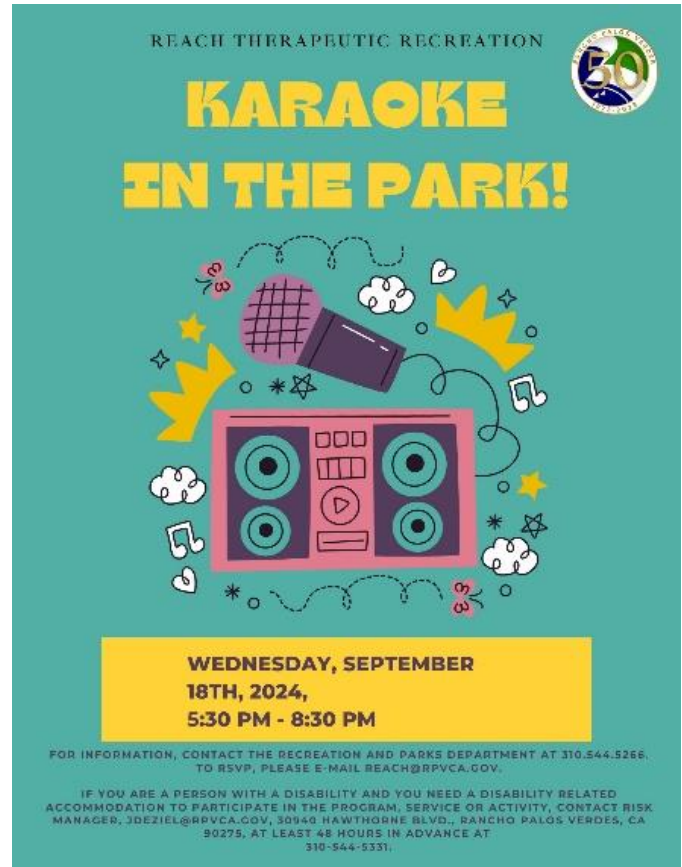

### **Excessive Heat**

High temperatures were recorded across Los Angeles County last week. Open Space Management Staff continued to patrol the Preserve and provided water and assistance to visitors to help stay cool.

### **A Day in Nature at Deane Dana Friendship Park**

On September 7, Staff participated in *A Day in Nature* public outreach event hosted by Los Angeles County Parks & Recreation. Staff had a booth to provide information to visitors about the Palos Verdes Nature Preserve.





## Abalone Cove Reserve

On September 4, Staff removed graffiti on one of the park picnic tables.



On September 4, Staff removed black graffiti on one of several Marine Protected Areas signs located on Abalone Cove Trail.



On September 8, Park Rangers, Park Rangers responded to a report of a deceased rattlesnake near the beach at Abalone Cove. The cause of death is unknown; however, the snake was bloated and did not appear to have open cuts or wounds.

### **Filiorum Reserve**

On September 9, the 200-foot overlook section on Jack's Hat was temporarily closed due to maintenance taking place in the area. The trail itself continues to remain open. The overlook area on Jack's Hat will be temporarily closed through Friday, September 13. This is due to vegetation removal project conducted by the Land Conservancy.

On September 10, Staff performed repairs to a trail counter located on Rattlesnake Trail.

### **Forrestal Reserve**

On September 10, Park Rangers performed inspections and repairs on the tread of Flying Mane Trail due to land movement.





On September 10, Staff inspected and removed two stumps from adjacent vegetation protruding onto the trail bed on Flying Mane Trail.





## Portuguese Bend Reserve

On September 9, Park Rangers conducted trimming of lemonade berry on Burma Road Trail near the trailhead and near Fire Station Trail.



On September 9, Staff performed trimming on Peacock Flats Trail.





## San Ramon Reserve

On September 6, Park Rangers removed graffiti from the Orientation Panel near the top of Marymount Trail.



On September 8, Park Rangers observed an irrigation leak at the bottom of Palos Verdes Drive South, adjacent to the Reserve. A report was made to Public Works.

## Vista del Norte Reserve

On September 7, Park Rangers received reports of ongoing issues regarding use of bikes at this Reserve. Bicycles, including e-bikes are not permitted on these trails. Continued use has resulted in rutting and damage to the trails. Park Rangers will continue to monitor the area.
