CITY MANAGER

Mayor Cruikshank and Former Mayor Brooks Test Positive for COVID-19: On March 23, the City announced that Rancho Palos Verdes Mayor John Cruikshank and former Mayor Susan Brooks have tested positive for COVID-19. Both are at home in isolation. Read the City's press release at: bit.ly/3doNG7I

On March 24, Mayor Cruikshank released the following message:

Dear Residents,

Thank you for the outpouring of support and well wishes I have received over the past 24 hours. I am happy to report that after getting plenty of rest and following my doctor's orders, I am feeling much better. Although Mayor Pro Tem Alegria has shown no symptoms of illness, we both remain in home isolation.

I want to reassure you that when Eric and I learned we had potentially been exposed to COVID-19, we took the necessary precautions to protect those around us, and continue to do so. The health and well-being of our residents is a top priority. Please know that all appropriate steps have been taken to ensure the safety of our community.

Certainly, everyone who attended former Mayor Brooks' party over two weeks ago wishes we knew then what we know now, but public health officials had not yet put in place the social distancing measures and prohibitions on gatherings that have dramatically changed our way of life since.

Having gone through this experience puts me in an important position to let our community know that we can get through this. Even though I had four miserable days, I survived them. We can survive this. But we must all do our part to keep each other safe. That means staying at home except for essential needs, practicing physical distancing, washing your hands frequently and following all guidelines from our public health agencies.

Now more than ever is our time to embody what it means to be a good neighbor. Let's give this all we've got. Together we can help flatten the curve by adhering to social distancing and the "Safer at Home" Order.

Closure of City Parks and Open Space Areas due to COVID-19: On March 23, in accordance with guidance from state and local health officials to slow the spread of COVID-19, the City announced **the closure of the Palos Verdes Nature Preserve, all City parks, beaches, community centers, amenities and trails until further notice. All park buildings, playgrounds, parking lots, restrooms, game courts, and fields are closed. All park programming has been canceled until further notice. This includes all recreational activities, indoor and outdoor sports leagues, instructional courses, and group**

sessions/private events. Staff has notified the California Coastal Commission of the closure of facilities and amenities in the coastal zone.

The closures are in accordance with a local emergency proclamation adopted by the City Council on March 17, and come after City Staff and Park Rangers observed a high volume of visitors to City parks and the Palos Verdes Nature Preserve despite the “Safer at Home” Public Health Officer Order calling for social distancing.

COVID-19 Volunteer Assistance for Senior Citizens: Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District (PVPUSD) Board Member Linda Reid has volunteered her time and efforts in coordinating a volunteer effort to match volunteers with senior citizens in need of grocery, meal, or errand help in the Peninsula. CPUC Extends Rule 20 Comment Deadline: In response to the statewide disruption of normal municipal operations, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has extended the public comment deadline for proposed changes to Rule 20 from March 31 until April 21. As the City Council will recall, the League of California Cities has adopted a policy supporting the use of Rule 20 undergrounding funds in locations subject to wildfire hazard, while the CPUC is now proposing new rules that could undermine this policy.

Ring Security Device Subsidy Match Program: The City’s Ring Security Device Subsidy Match Program is continuing for all first-time, RPV residents to participate. **Ring continues to verify residency, provide the unique discount codes, and fulfill orders.** Information regarding the Ring Security Device Subsidy Match Program is available on the City website under the [spotlight](#). Alert SouthBay Registration - Everbridge Emergency Communication Notification System: The City of Rancho Palos Verdes has launched Alert SouthBay, an emergency communication notification system, a multi-jurisdictional coordinate approach to emergency management with 12 other South Bay cities. Everbridge will act as the City’s primary vehicle for emergency communication, as well as public-safety related messaging: ranging from road closures due to water main breaks or police activity, to critical emergency communications such as Shelter in Place or Evacuation notifications.

The City encourages all residents and members of the Rancho Palos Verdes community to opt-in and register for Everbridge. There are three easy methods for registering:

- Text to 888-777 with the message “alerts” (one word), which returns a link to register for Everbridge
- Download the free Everbridge app on an iOS or Android device from the App Store or Google Play Store
- Register online at <https://alertsouthbay.com/>

Public Records Request during City Hall Closure: Pursuant to RPV Resolution No. 2020-11, the City Council has declared a state of local emergency in cooperation with federal, state, and county declarations of emergency. Due to these emergency circumstances, the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will only be providing essential city services that are necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of our community and city employees. To facilitate these measures, all non-essential staff is currently working remotely and therefore City administrative operations are limited. Please note that the City’s response to your PRA request may be delayed. We expect to address your PRA request when normal business operations resume.

FINANCE

Federal Income Tax Filing Deadline Moved to July 15th: Federal income tax filing and payment relief on account of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) emergency. The Treasury Department and IRS are providing relief to all taxpayers who have Federal income tax returns and Federal income tax payments due on April 15, 2020. The April 15, 2020 deadline is postponed to July 15, 2020. Associated interest, additions to tax, and penalties for late filing or late payment will be suspended until July 15, 2020.

Plan announced to implement Coronavirus-related paid leave for workers and tax credits for small and midsize businesses: The U.S. Treasury Department, Internal Revenue Service (IRS), and the U.S. Department of Labor (Labor) announced that small and midsize employers can begin taking advantage of two new refundable payroll tax credits, designed to immediately and fully reimburse them, dollar-for-dollar, for the cost of providing Coronavirus-related leave to their employees. This relief to employees and small and midsize businesses is provided under the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (Act), signed on March 18, 2020.

The Act will help the United States combat and defeat COVID-19 by giving all American businesses with fewer than 500 employees funds to provide employees with paid leave, either for the employee's own health needs or to care for family members. The legislation will enable employers to keep their workers on their payrolls, while at the same time ensuring that workers are not forced to choose between their paychecks and the public health measures needed to combat the virus.



The message boards have been placed at the Del Cerro entrance, Hawthorne Blvd. and Granvia Altamira, Palos Verdes Drive South, the switchbacks, and at Crenshaw Blvd. and Crest Rd. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

2020 Census Update: Most households by now have received official mail from the U.S. Census Bureau to respond to the 2020 Census online, by phone, or by mail. The U.S Census Bureau recently launched a webpage to view the self-response rate of each City, in which the City of Rancho Palos Verdes is showing the following results as of March 23, 2020.

Application and Permit Submittals: The City's Community Development Department continues to provide permitting and inspections services during the City Hall closure to the public. Planning and permit applications and plans are being accepted electronically by submitting to Planning@rpvca.gov. Hard copy plans can also be accepted via designated drop-off area at the Community Development Department. If hard copy plans are being submitted, it is recommended that an applicant coordinate with City Staff prior to plan drop off.

Inspection requests can be submitted electronically by visiting the following link: <http://www.rpvca.gov/FormCenter/Community-Development-5/Inspection-ERequest-57>. Staff is conducting inspections of both interior and exterior improvements.

Virtual Building Inspection: Staff has developed a protocol and have implemented a virtual inspection program for certain types of residential construction inspections. Utilizing live video and/or recorded videos to ensure adherence to City Codes but to allow construction to proceed. Some types of inspections are continuing in-person.

RECREATION & PARKS

Park Closure Update: Record crowds were observed at the park and Preserve facilities this past weekend. Beginning last Friday, there were only closures of park buildings. On Sunday, this was adjusted to include the closures of the public restrooms. As of Monday, as a part of the Council-declared local emergency, full closure of all facilities were ordered. This week, staff is working diligently to sign and physically close all access to these areas. In preparation for the weekend, staff will be on site at multiple locations to monitor and educate the public when appropriate. Additionally, Staff is coordinating with HOA representative adjacent to parks and the Preserve to monitor activities. The following notice has been posted at City parks and Preserve:



PUBLIC NOTICE

Per City Council-adopted Resolution No. 2020-11 declaring a local emergency, out of an abundance of caution and in accordance with guidance from State and local health officials to contain the spread of COVID-19, all public parks, beaches, open space, community centers, park parking lots, amenities and trails are **CLOSED**.

The City is implementing the following changes effective as of March 23, 2020 until further notice:

- . All park locations, including buildings, playgrounds, dog parks, parking lots, restrooms, game courts, and fields, are **CLOSED**.
- . All park programming has been **CANCELLED**. This includes all recreational activities, indoor and outdoor sports leagues, instructional courses, and group sessions/private events.
- . All beaches, reserves in the Palos Verdes Nature Preserve and other open space locations, including trails, staging areas, and viewpoints, are **CLOSED**.
