CRIME SUMMARY

Crimes reported during this time period in the City of Rancho Palos Verdes included one residential burglary, two vehicle burglaries, one commercial burglary, three grand thefts (vehicle), one grand theft, three petty thefts and four acts of vandalism.

January 30

Residential Burglary - A victim reported that between December 15th, 2005 and January 15th, 2006, person(s) unknown stole jewelry and U.S. currency from a home in the 28000 block of Palos Verdes Drive East. There was no sign of forced entry.
