NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on **November 28, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.** (note early start time) at Hesse Park Community Building, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes. On November 14, 2017, the Planning Commission will be asked to continue, without discussion, the public hearing to November 28, 2017 to re-notice the public hearing to now consider the following applications:

CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT, VARIANCE, GRADING PERMIT & MASTER SIGN

PROGRAM - Case No. ZON2017-00030 – A request to demolish an existing 5,501ft² vacant restaurant building (former Coco's Restaurant) and to construct a new 4,131ft² Chase bank building with a total of 48 parking spaces (including 17 additional parking spaces); a refurbished existing parking lot with new landscaping, lighting, and related site improvements; a Variance application to allow the existing legal non-conforming lot coverage of 77% (50% max allowed) to remain; 1,563yd³ of grading, consisting of 1,438yd³ of cut and 125yd³ of fill (1,310 yd³ of export); and a Master Sign Program to allow various types of signs on-site including the existing monument sign to remain.
