CODE AMENDMENT (CASE NO. ZON2017-00595): A City initiated request to amend Chapter 17.60 (Conditional Use Permit) of Title 17 (Zoning) of the Rancho Palos Verdes Municipal Code to: 1) clarify which governing bodies conduct future compliance reviews; and 2) add a new Future Compliance Review fee for Conditional Use Permits to the City's Master Schedule of Fees and Charges for City Services.
