**VESTING TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP NO. 72981 (CASE NO. SUB2014-00005):** A request to subdivide an existing 43,590ft<sup>2</sup> vacant lot at the west end of Marion Drive into two separate residential lots measuring 23,485ft<sup>2</sup> (Lot No. 1) and 20,025ft<sup>2</sup> (Lot No. 2) in size.
