



# RPV's FREE DOCUMENT SHREDDING & ELECTRONICS WASTE ROUNDUP & FREE MULCH GIVEAWAY

EDCO and the City of Rancho Palos Verdes (RPV) are sponsoring a free document/paper shredding event on **Saturday, May 2 from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.** at the RPV Civic Center (City Hall Overflow Parking lot) located at 30940 Hawthorne Boulevard.

There will be three popular activities happening concurrently at this location; therefore, there will be a special event day traffic control plan in the vicinity of the Civic Center. Please drive carefully and observe all traffic signs.

1) **DOCUMENT SHREDDING**- The perfect opportunity for RPV residents to safely and confidentially dispose of personal documents. During this event, certified document shredding trucks will be on-site to shred your documents **on-site**. Acceptable items include: payroll stubs, credit card and bank statements, credit applications, tax documents, legal documents, mortgage and escrow documents, medical records, or any type of confidential information. No records will leave the site unshredded.



Note: Documents with paper clips, staples, or bindings is acceptable and no need to remove them. However, if your items are in a 3-ring metal binder, please remove them from the binder. There is a **limit of three** bankers boxes (approximately 10"x12"x15") per household. Paper in bags will also be accepted. This event is for residential customers of EDCO only. Proof of residency in RPV will be required (CDL, utility bill, etc.). **This event is for shredding of household documents only. It is not for businesses. Businesses should not bring their documents for shredding and they will be turned back.**

2) **ELECTRONICS WASTE ROUNDUP**- During the same time, day, and location EDCO will also collect obsolete or unwanted electronics (TVs, computers, monitors, cellular phones, microwaves, fax machines, printers, etc.) from residents.



Note: Absolutely **no hazardous waste material (no paint, no chemicals, no sharps)** will be accepted.

3) **MULCH GIVEAWAY**- Free mulch will be available at that time for self-load/self-haul/self-serve (while supplies last). Bring your trashcans (up to 3) and your own gloves and shovels. If you have an open truck or trailer, please bring a tarp to cover your material.
