NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, October 22, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. at Hesse Park Community Building, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes to consider the following:

CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT - COMMERCIAL ANTENNA (CASE NO. PLCU-0004): A request to extend the Conditional Use Permit (Case No. ZON2009-00182) for the continued operation of an existing Wireless Telecommunications Facility (T-Mobile) consisting of a 45' tall monopole and a 365ft² equipment structure located at the rear of the Hilltop Automotive property. No modifications are proposed to the existing wireless facility as part of this application.

Only those who have submitted written comments at or prior to, and/or given testimony at the public hearing will receive notification of the decision. The Planning Commission's decision may then be appealed, in writing, to the City Council.

If you would like the opportunity to review the application package and the proposed plans, they are on file in the Community Development Department at 30940 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes, and are available for review from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Friday.
