NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Director of Community Development of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will consider an application for the following project:

Special Use Permit (PLSU2021-0002) – A request to allow Green Hills Memorial Park to stay open until 9:00pm, 2 hours past the usual Daylight Savings closing time of 7:00 p.m, and conduct an invitation-only 15 minute fireworks show on Sunday, May 30, 2021, to commemorate the display of “The Moving Wall”, which is a traveling half-size replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. The event will comply with Los Angeles County Public Health COVID-19 protocols.

**APPLICANT/
LANDOWNER:** Green Hills Memorial Park

This project is categorically exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land). The proposed event will be a temporary use of the land having negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; therefore, no further environmental review is required.

By doing so, you will ensure that your comments are taken into consideration for the staff analysis of the project. Only those who have submitted written comments will receive notification of the decision. The Director’s decision may then be appealed, in writing, to the Planning Commission.

If you would like the opportunity to review the application package, it is on file in the Community Development Department at 30940 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes, and are available for review from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Friday. **In light of COVID-19 response measures from the Governor of the State of California and the Los Angeles County Public Health Department, and in the interest of the health and well-being of residents and City employees, City Hall is limiting counter hours and walk-ins by appointment only.**
