### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on July 20, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. Pursuant to Section 3 of Executive Order N-29-20, issued by Governor Newsom on March 17, 2020, the regular meeting of the City Council for July 20, 2021, will be conducted through a \*hybrid combination of in-person and/or all virtual attendance of the five members of the City Council and invited staff at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at [rpvca.gov/agendas](http://rpvca.gov/agendas) and on PVPtv channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiOS 39. Public participation is highly encouraged using the virtual platform as there will be very limited seating (with a combined total of 25 people between two rooms) at Hesse Park. Please note that depending on the COVID-19 circumstances in the following weeks, an amended notice may be issued on the change from a virtual meeting to a regular meeting at Hesse Park Community Building, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes. The City Council will consider the following:


**Coastal Permit for Oceanfront Estates Residential Permit Parking Plan (Case No. PLCP2021-0001):** A request to consider adopting a residential permit parking plan to limit on-street parking along Paseo De La Luz, Calle Cortada, Via Del Cielo, Calle Viento, and Pacifica Del Mar, to residents of Oceanfront Estates and their guests. The permit parking program would be applicable 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.
