NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, September 7, 2021, at 7:00 PM. Pursuant to Section 3 of [Executive Order N-29-20](#), issued by Governor Newsom on March 17, 2020, the regular meeting of the City Council for September 7, 2021, will be conducted through a hybrid combination of in-person attendance with not less than three members of the City Council, invited staff, and limited members of the public at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at rpvca.gov/agendas and on RPTV channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiOS 39. The City Council will consider the following:

AN APPEAL OF A PLANNING COMMISSION-DENIED SITE PLAN REVIEW, MAJOR GRADING PERMIT, AND MINOR EXCEPTION PERMIT (CASE NO. PLGR2019-0025)

– A request that the City Council overturn the Planning Commission's decision to deny the proposed Site Plan Review, Major Grading Permit, and Minor Exception Permit to allow the following improvements on a vacant lot:

- Construction of a new 4,350 ft² (3,821 ft² residence and 529 ft² attached garage) split-story residence;
- Construction of ancillary site improvements, including two air conditioning units, eight skylights, a new motor-court, a 678 ft² roof deck with outdoor kitchen, a 210 ft² balcony, a stairway along each side yard, a 6-foot tall wood fence along the front, rear and side property lines, a 5-foot tall retaining wall along the rear façade, terraced planters up to 8 feet-6 inches in height along the front of the residence, and landscaping strips (hedges) along the front and side yards; and
- On-site grading, consisting of 1,049 yd³ of associated grading (798 yd³ of cut and 251 yd³ of fill with 547 yd³ of export) to accommodate the proposed improvements.

The height of the proposed residence will be 4 feet as measured from highest elevation of the existing grade covered by the structure (elev. 153.5 feet) to the highest proposed roof ridgeline (elev. 157.5 feet); and an overall height of 30 feet as measured from lowest finished grade adjacent to the structure (elev. 127.5 feet) to the highest proposed roof ridgeline (elev. 157.5 feet).
