NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a meeting on Tuesday, October 19, 2021, at 7:00 PM. Pursuant to Section 3 of Executive Order N-29-20, issued by Governor Newsom on March 17, 2020, the regular meeting of the City Council for September 21, 2021, will be conducted through a hybrid combination of in-person attendance with not less than three members of the City Council, invited staff, and limited members of the public at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at rpvca.gov/agendas and on RPVtv channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiOS 39. The City Council will consider the following:

REVIEW OF DRAFT 2021-2029 HOUSING ELEMENT– All cities in California are required to adopt a comprehensive General Plan to guide land use planning decisions. A key part of the City's overall General Plan is the Housing Element, which have been mandatory portions of local general plans in California since 1969. The current adopted Housing Element covers the period 2013-2021 and must be updated for the next planning cycle (6th Cycle) covering the period 2021-2029.

The Housing Element must be updated to include City policies, strategies, and actions to facilitate the construction of new housing and preservation of existing housing to meet the needs of the population during the 6th Cycle period. The Housing Element must also plan for the City's Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA) allocation of a total of 639 new housing units in various income levels through the next 6th RHNA Cycle.
