NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, at 7:00 PM. Pursuant to Section 3 of [Executive Order N-29-20](#), issued by Governor Newsom on March 17, 2020, the meeting of November 2, 2021, will take place remotely in accordance with Government Code Section 54953(e) et seq. (AB 361), and will be conducted through a *hybrid combination of in-person and/or all virtual attendance of the five members of the City Council and invited staff at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at rpvca.gov/agendas and on PVPtv channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiOS 39. Public participation is highly encouraged using the virtual platform as there will be very limited seating (with a combined total of 25 people between two rooms) at Hesse Park. Members of the public can observe and participate using the public participation options. Please note that depending on the COVID-19 circumstances in the following weeks, an amended notice may be issued on the change from a virtual meeting to a regular meeting at Hesse Park Community Building, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos Verdes. The City Council will consider the following:

Code Amendment (PLCA2021-0003) – A request to consider adopting an ordinance repealing and replacing Section 17.76.050 (Sign Permit) and to add Chapter 17.75 (Sign Code) to Article VII (Development Application and Review) of Title 17 (Zoning) of the Rancho Palos Verdes Municipal Code, to update the City's sign regulations.

LOCATION: Citywide

APPLICANT: City of Rancho Palos Verdes

Staff has reviewed the proposed code amendments for compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and determined that the proposed Code Amendment is exempt from CEQA, pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3).

Written comments submitted after noon on Friday, October 22, 2021, will be given to the City Council on the night of the meeting as late correspondence. Please note that written materials, including emails, submitted to the City are public records and may be posted on the City's website. Accordingly, you may wish to omit personal information from your written materials as it may become part of the public record. In addition, this virtual City meeting will be televised and can be accessed through the City's website.

If you would like the opportunity to discuss or review the proposed code amendment, it is on file in the Community Development Department at 30940 Hawthorne Boulevard, Rancho Palos

Verdes, and is available for review from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Friday. In light of COVID-19 response measures from the Governor of the State of California and the Los Angeles County Public Health Department, and in the interest of the health and well-being of residents and City employees, City Hall is limiting counter hours and walk-ins by appointment only. Staff is also able to provide electronic files upon request.
