2021 California Association of Code Enforcement Officers (CACEO) Seminar

Code Enforcement Division staff recently attended the 2021 CACEO seminar, which provides Code Enforcement Officers an opportunity to earn continuing education units towards the certification as a Certified Code Enforcement Officer through CACEO. The four-day event was packed with several informative courses geared towards current events happening throughout the State of California. Topic of discussions included:

- Code Enforcement in a Time of Criminal Justice Reform and Shifting Policing
- Annual Code Enforcement Legal Updates
- Sidewalk Vending in California
- Inspection and Abatement Warrants 101
- Overview of ADU/JADU Regulations

On closing day, SB296 Code Enforcement Officer Safety bill was signed into law. This bill requires, for the first time ever, all cities and counties to adopt safety standards specific to code enforcement officers and the hazards and threats they face in their respective jurisdictions. This is the first CEO safety bill in the nation.
