The meeting will take place in accordance with Government Code § 549539(e) et seq (AB 361) and pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-21, adopted by the City Council on April 19, 2022, and as renewed by subsequent resolution(s) thereafter. The regular meeting of the Planning Commission will be conducted through a hybrid combination of in-person and/or all virtual attendance of the Planning Commission and invited staff at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at [rpvca.gov/agendas](http://rpvca.gov/agendas) and on PVPtv channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiOS 39.
