NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 15, 2022, at 7:00 PM.

The meeting will take place remotely in accordance with Government Code Section 54953(e) et seq. (AB 361) and pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-21, adopted by the City Council on June 21, 2022, and as renewed by subsequent resolution(s) thereafter. The meeting will be conducted through a *hybrid combination of in-person and/or all virtual attendance of the five members of the City Council and invited staff at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at rpvca.gov/agendas and on PVPtv channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiberOptic 39. Public participation is highly encouraged using the virtual platform as there will be very limited seating (with a combined total of 25 people between two rooms) at Hesse Park. The City Council will consider the following:

MORATORIUM PERIOD EXTENSION FOR ANTENNAS (CASE NO. PLCA2022-0008): On October 4, 2022, the City Council adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 665U to establish a temporary 45-day moratorium on the entitlement, establishment, expansion, or modification of antennas governed pursuant to §17.76.020 (Antennas) of Title 17 (Zoning) of the Rancho Palos Verdes Municipal Code (RPVMC), and to initiate code amendment proceedings to the aforementioned section with new regulations governing antennas on private property based on current federal telecommunication laws. As the moratorium period is set to expire on November 18, 2022, the City Council will consider extending the moratorium period pursuant to §65858 of the California Government Code to allow time for Staff to continue processing the code amendment initiated by the City Council. This moratorium does not apply to those antennas protected by state and/or federal law.
