**NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 15, 2022, at 7:00 PM.

The meeting will take place remotely in accordance with Government Code Section 54953(e) et seq. (AB 361) and pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-21, adopted by the City Council on June 21, 2022, and as renewed by subsequent resolution(s) thereafter. The meeting will be conducted through a \*hybrid combination of in-person and/or all virtual attendance of the five members of the City Council and invited staff at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and via teleconference using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at [rpvca.gov/agendas](http://rpvca.gov/agendas) and on PVPtv channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiberOptic 39. Public participation is highly encouraged using the virtual platform as there will be very limited seating (with a combined total of 25 people between two rooms) at Hesse Park. The City Council will consider the following:

**COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT (CASE NO. PLCP2022-0001):** A proposal to allow an after-the-fact permit parking program for residents within the community of Abalone Cove, consisting of Seacove Drive, Packet Road, Barkentine Road, and Clipper Road.

If you have any comments or concerns about the proposed project, please communicate those thoughts in writing to Senior Planner, Jaehee Yoon, by noon on Monday, November 7, 2022. By doing so, you will ensure that your comments are taken into consideration for the Staff Report. Written comments submitted after noon on Monday, November 7, 2022, will be given separately to the City Council as Late Correspondence prior to the meeting.

Please note that written materials, including emails, submitted to the City are public records and may be posted on the City's website. Accordingly, you may wish to omit personal information from your written materials as it may become part of the public record. In addition, City meetings may be televised and may be accessed through the City's website. Only those who have submitted written comments at or prior to, and/or given testimony at the public hearing will receive notification of the decision.

The City Council's decision on this application may be appealed to the Coastal Commission as portions of the project area are within the appealable area of the City's Coastal Zone. The appeal letter must be filed within ten (10) working days following the City Council's final action. If no timely appeal is filed to the Coastal Commission, the City Council's decision will be final.
