### May 17, 2023 LAX Community Noise Roundtable Meeting Summary

On May 17, 2023, the LAX Community Noise Roundtable held a regularly scheduled meeting to discuss a range of agenda items (attached) involving noise concerns caused by passenger jets arriving and departing from LAX (Los Angeles International Airport). Of particular importance to the Peninsula communities, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) provided a brief status update on the delayed implementation of two LAX departure procedures titled KYLOW and STHBY, between the hours of midnight and 6:30 a.m. As a reminder, on February 7, 2023, the City Council expressed concerns that these procedures would vector noisy aircraft closer to the Peninsula and sent an opposition letter to the FAA requesting changes. The FAA updated the Roundtable that FAA technicians are continuing the review of the City's and LAWA's departure procedure recommendations, and that the FAA will provide an update at a future Roundtable meeting.



During the meeting, LAWA staff also distributed passenger jet PV Peninsula overflight and altitude data for flights that occurred during March-April (attached). 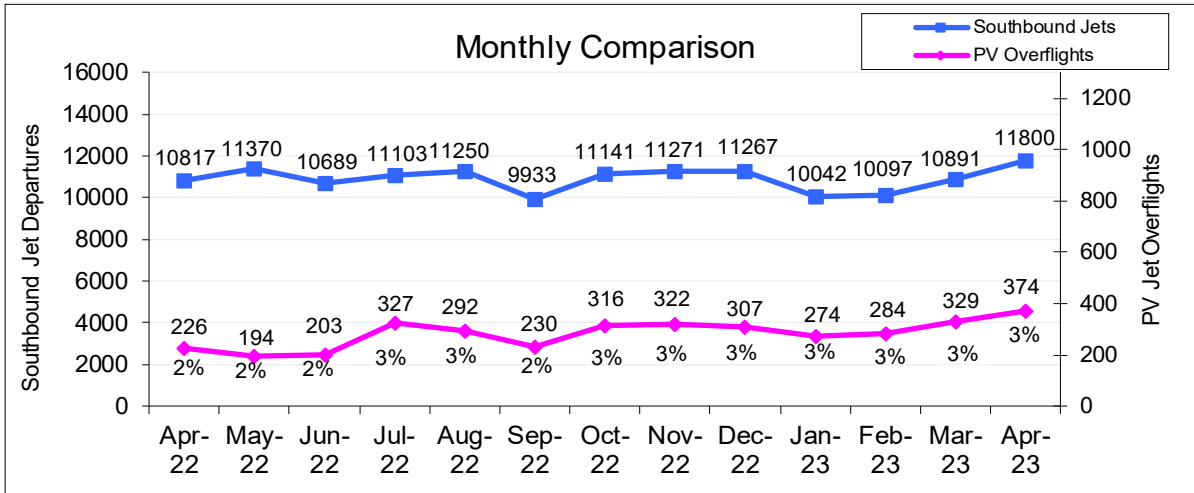
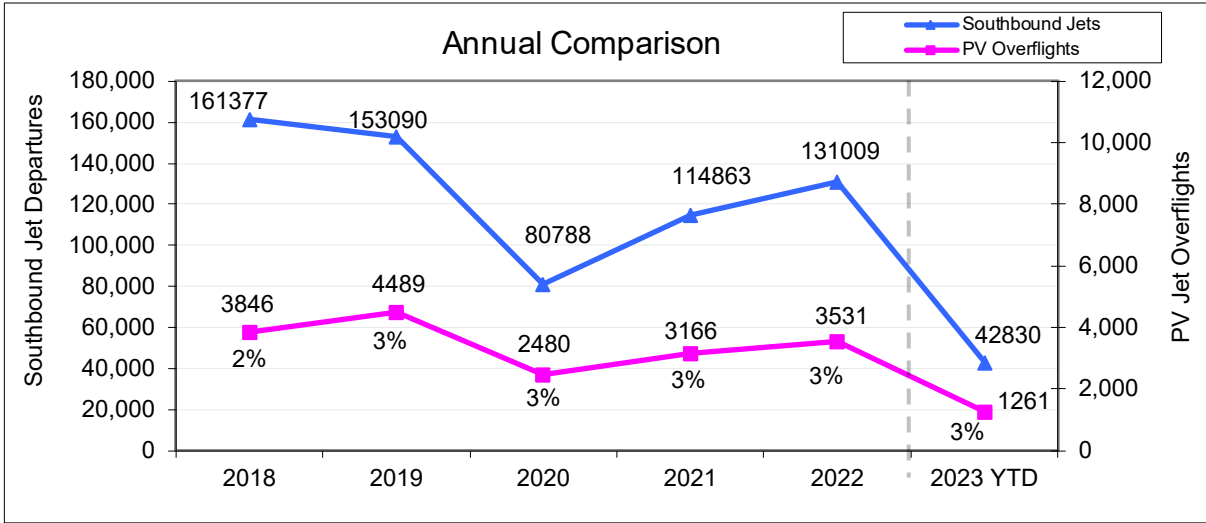
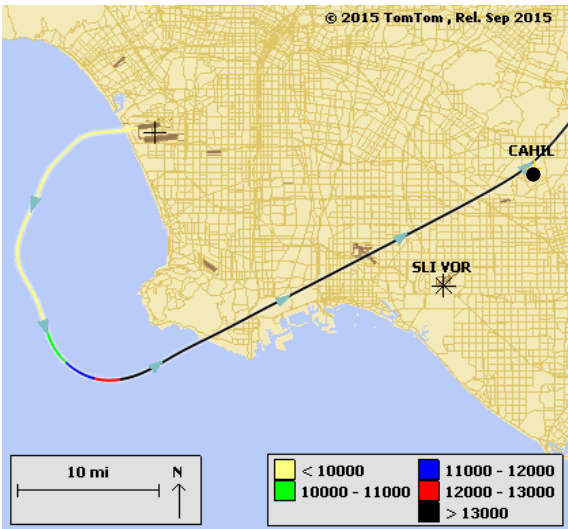
