NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Director of Community Development of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will consider an application for the following project:

MAJOR SITE PLAN REVIEW WITH NEIGHBORHOOD COMPATIBILITY AND MINOR GRADING PERMIT (CASE NO. PLSR2023-0049) – A request for the following improvements to an existing single-family residence:

- Construct a 1,320 ft² addition to an existing 2,091 ft² single-story residence for a new total structure size of 3,411 ft² (garage included); remodel 616 ft² of the interior of the existing residence and ancillary site improvements, including a new 534 ft² rear patio, a replacement 3.5-foot-high retaining wall, and a replacement wood fence along the southern side yard.

The proposed addition will measure 15.8 feet, as measured from the lowest finished grade covered by structure (elev. 733.35) to the highest roof ridgeline (elev. 749.15); and a height of 14.67 feet as measured from the highest elevation of the existing grade covered by the structure (elev. 734.48) to the highest roof ridgeline (elev. 749.15).

This project is categorically exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act, Section 15301 Existing Facilities.

This frame will be in place throughout the duration of the public comment period to better assist you and the City in assessing any potential project impacts.

Accordingly, you may wish to omit personal information from your written materials as it may become part of the public record. Only those who have submitted written comments will receive

notification of the decision. The Director's decision may then be appealed, in writing, to the Planning Commission.
