PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct a public hearing on **Tuesday, April 23, 2024**, at 7:00 PM.

The meeting will take place in accordance with the requirements of the Ralph M. Brown Act, Section 54950 et seq. of the Government Code. Remote participation by any Committee/Commission member shall be in accordance with Subdivisions (b)(3) or (f) of Government Code Section 54953. The meetings are held at Hesse Park, McTaggart Hall, 29301 Hawthorne Boulevard and/or via teleconference for staff/consultants/participants using the Zoom platform and broadcast live on the City's website at rpvca.gov/agendas and on PVPTv channels Cox 35 and Frontier FiberOptic 39. Public participation will be in person and using the virtual platform. The Planning Commission will consider the following proposed project:

APPEAL OF A SITE PLAN REVIEW WITH NEIGHBORHOOD COMPATIBILITY, AND MAJOR GRADING PERMIT (CASE NO. PLHV2022-0001) – On February 15, 2024, the Director of Community Development conditionally approved a Site Plan Review with Neighborhood Compatibility application to construct a 742 ft² single-story addition to an existing 2,533 ft² single-story residence (garage included) resulting in a new total structure size of 3,275 ft²; along with ancillary site improvements; and after-the-fact grading (39 yd³ of cut). A timely appeal of the approved application was filed by an interested party.
