LAX Community Noise Roundtable Meeting Summary

On March 20, the LAX Community Noise Roundtable held its regularly scheduled meeting. The meeting included a report from Rancho Palos Verdes Staff on the recent UC Davis Aviation Noise and Emissions Symposium. The Symposium is a conference by stakeholders seeking noise and emissions reduction from aircraft, which included the Federal Aviation Administration, airport managers, airplane company owners, consultants, and community groups.



The meeting concluded with Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) distributing passenger jet data for flights that occurred in January and February 2024 (see attachments). Upcoming Peafowl Census

From April 8-13, the City of Rancho Palos Verdes will conduct an annual peafowl census to assess the current peafowl population throughout six City Council-approved neighborhoods, including:

- Crestridge
- Grandview
- Monaco
- Portuguese Bend
- Sunnyside Ridge
- Vista Grande



The census is conducted on two types of observations, counting roosting peafowl in trees at sunrise, and using a systematic grid pattern in the early evening hours. The results of the census will be reported to the City Council to determine if the City will reinstate trapping for the 2024 season. 




Palos Verdes Peninsula – Jet Overflights
