Coyote Sightings Dashboard Update

The City's Code Enforcement Division updated the color of informational icons used in the Coyote Sightings Dashboard. The icon colors were updated to reduce user confusion related to the status of reported incidents. The updated icon colors are noted in the corresponding color icon table. The new icon colors align more appropriately with the related incident reported.

As a reminder, residents may report coyote sightings from your mobile device or PC by visiting rpvca.gov/reportcoyotes. The coyote sightings web app allows users to report sightings and the activity of the coyote when spotted. The website will geo-locate the reported sighting on a live map where you may add comments and contact information. 2. If joining online, click on the “raise-hand” icon when the Chairperson calls for the item on which you wish you speak. The Chairperson will then call on/unmute you in turn to speak.
3. If joining by phone, enter *5 on your keypad to “raise your hand” when the Chairperson calls for the item on which you wish you speak. The Chairperson will then call on you in turn to speak; be sure to enter *6 to unmute yourself when called upon.

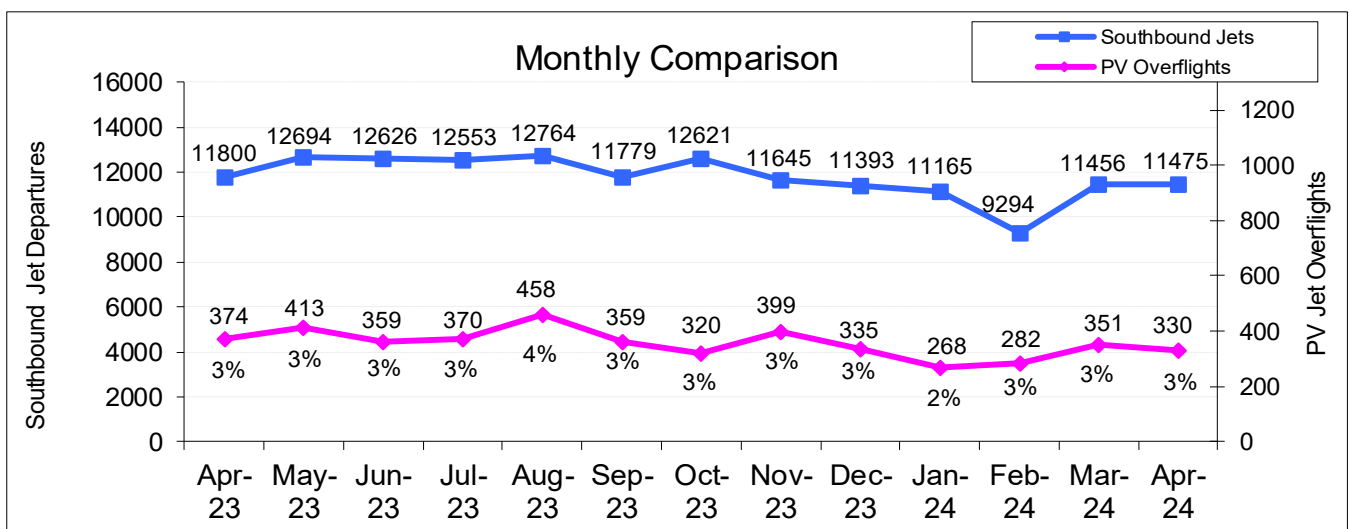
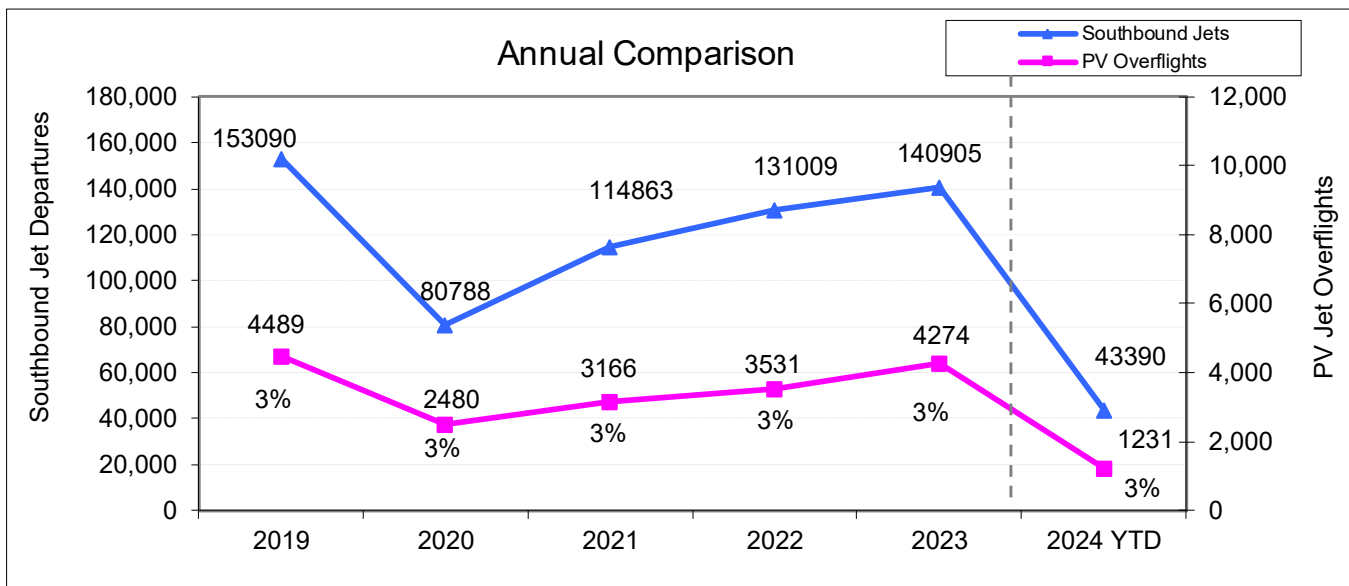
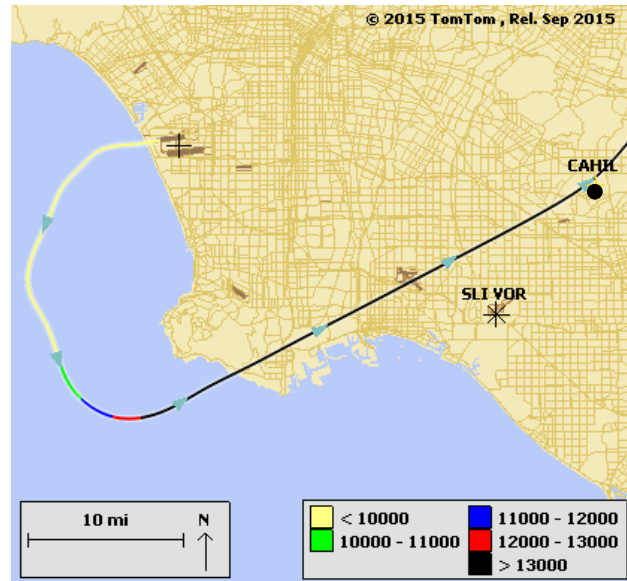
