Dear Ms. Jacobs,

This email is in regards to the above subject project. Please note that all of Southern California coastal cities are highly culturally sensitive; as these

areas were heavily populated by our ancestors. Palos Verdes was once known as Chowingna a historical Gabrieleno Indian village site. We're concerned with natural streams, water lines, creeks, and rivers as these areas were used for food & water supplies. Any excavation in these areas or surrounding Palos Verdes requires an experienced Native American monitor on site to protect our natural resources.

Furthermore, please note that the NAHC only searches for RECORDED sacred sites in the surrounding project area. They don't know of every sacred site as some have not been discovered yet. We're especially cautious when a project is near a known historic recorded village and confirmed by our Historian Elder Committee.

Please contact our office at 626-926-4131 to coordinate a monitor to be on this project site. We appreciate in advance your assistance with protecting our cultural resources.
