Dear Mr. Singleton,

SFC Consultants (SFC) on behalf of the City of Palos Verdes, requests your review of the Sacred Lands File for this site and provide a list of Native American Contacts for consultation, appropriate for this area of **Los Angeles County**.

Attached is a map of the proposed project and USGS topographic maps of the project area. The project lies in the south western section of Rancho Palos Verdes, near the border with the city of Los Angeles. It is north of Palos Verdes Drive South and east of Palos Verdes Drive East. The project alignment is in unsectioned land on the Palos Verdes Peninsula in Los Angeles County. The project area is depicted on the San Pedro, California USGS 7.5-minute topographic map. Coordinates are 33° - 43' - 44.93" N, 118° - 19' - 40.89" W.

The project will involve construction of a storm water collection system that will address the flooding and debris flow issues. Improvement is needed to address flooding and debris flow that periodically impact Palos Verdes South and downstream neighborhoods. Excessive flooding and subsequent debris flows also impact the storm drain system that currently collects low flow waters. The project area is approximately 3.75 miles in length. Final engineering drawings are not yet complete. A cultural resource survey is being prepared concurrent with this request and will be forwarded to Native Americans provided by the NAHC. 




